




In the bible, we can hear God speaking to us and we respond in prayer. Prayer becomes answering God. In all cases God is the initiator, hearing always precedes asking.




We should listen, study, think, reflect, and ponder the scriptures until there is an answering response in our hearts and minds. That response to God's speech is then truly prayer and should be given to God.
