Obeying the Law to earn God's favor

I am astonished that you are **so quickly deserting**
him who called you in the grace of Christ
and are **turning to a different gospel—**

(Galatians 1:6 ESV)

yet we know that a person **is not justified by works of the law**
but through faith in Jesus Christ,
so we also have believed in Christ Jesus, in order
to be justified by faith in Christ and not by works of the law,
because **by works of the law no one will be justified.**

(Galatians 2:16 ESV)

I do not nullify the grace of God,
for if righteousness were through the law,
then **Christ died for no purpose.**

(Galatians 2:21 ESV)

For all who rely on works of the law are under a curse;
for it is written, “Cursed be everyone who does not abide
by all things written in the Book of the Law, and do them.”
Now it is evident that **no one is justified before God by the law,**
for “The righteous shall live by faith.”

(Galatians 3:10-11 ESV)

or rather to be known by God, **how can you turn back again
to the weak and worthless elementary principles of the world,
whose slaves** you want to be once more?
