# The Old Priesthood or Covenant Can't Cleanse

According to this arrangement,  
gifts and sacrifices are offered that **cannot perfect**  
**the conscience** of the worshiper,

(Hebrews 9:9 ESV)



Now even the first covenant had regulations for worship and an earthly place of holiness. For a tent was prepared, the first section, in which were the lampstand and the table and the bread of the Presence. It is called the Holy Place.

Behind the second curtain was a second section called the Most Holy Place, having the golden altar of incense and the ark of the covenant covered on all sides with gold, in which was a golden urn holding the manna, and Aaron's staff that budded, and the tablets of the covenant.

Above it were the cherubim of glory overshadowing the mercy seat. Of these things we cannot now speak in detail.

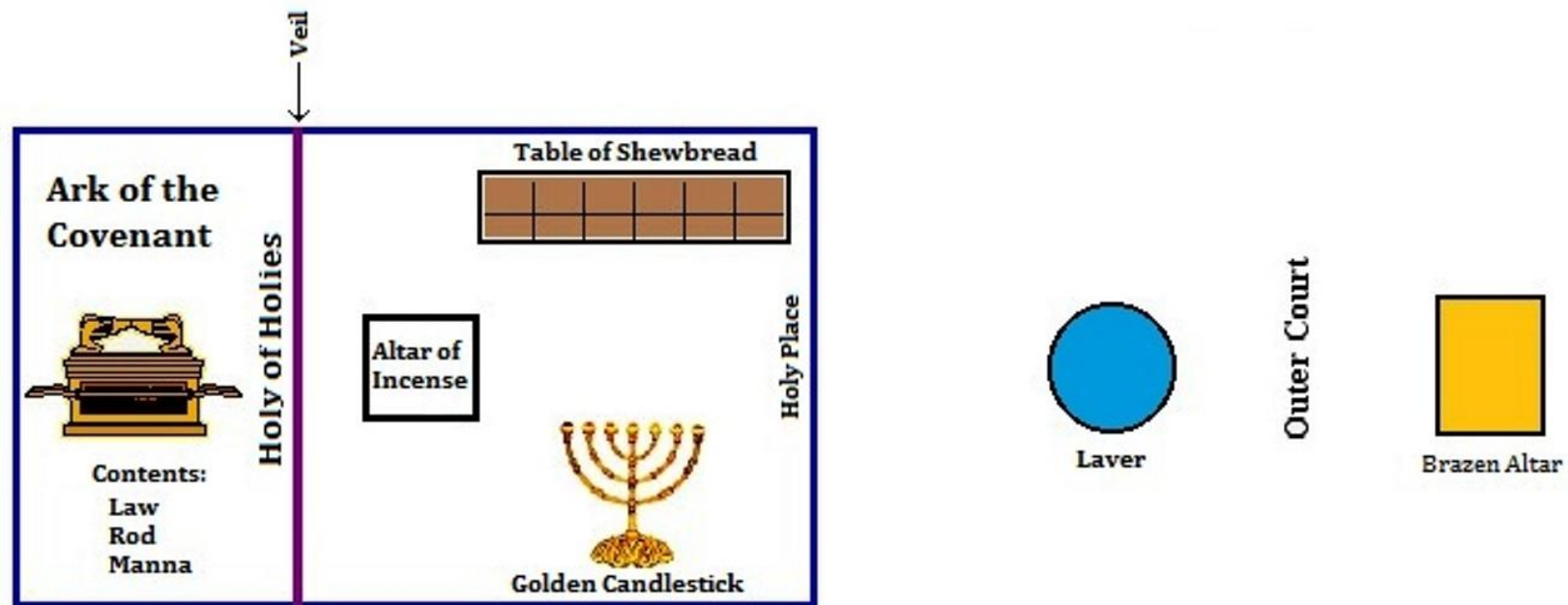

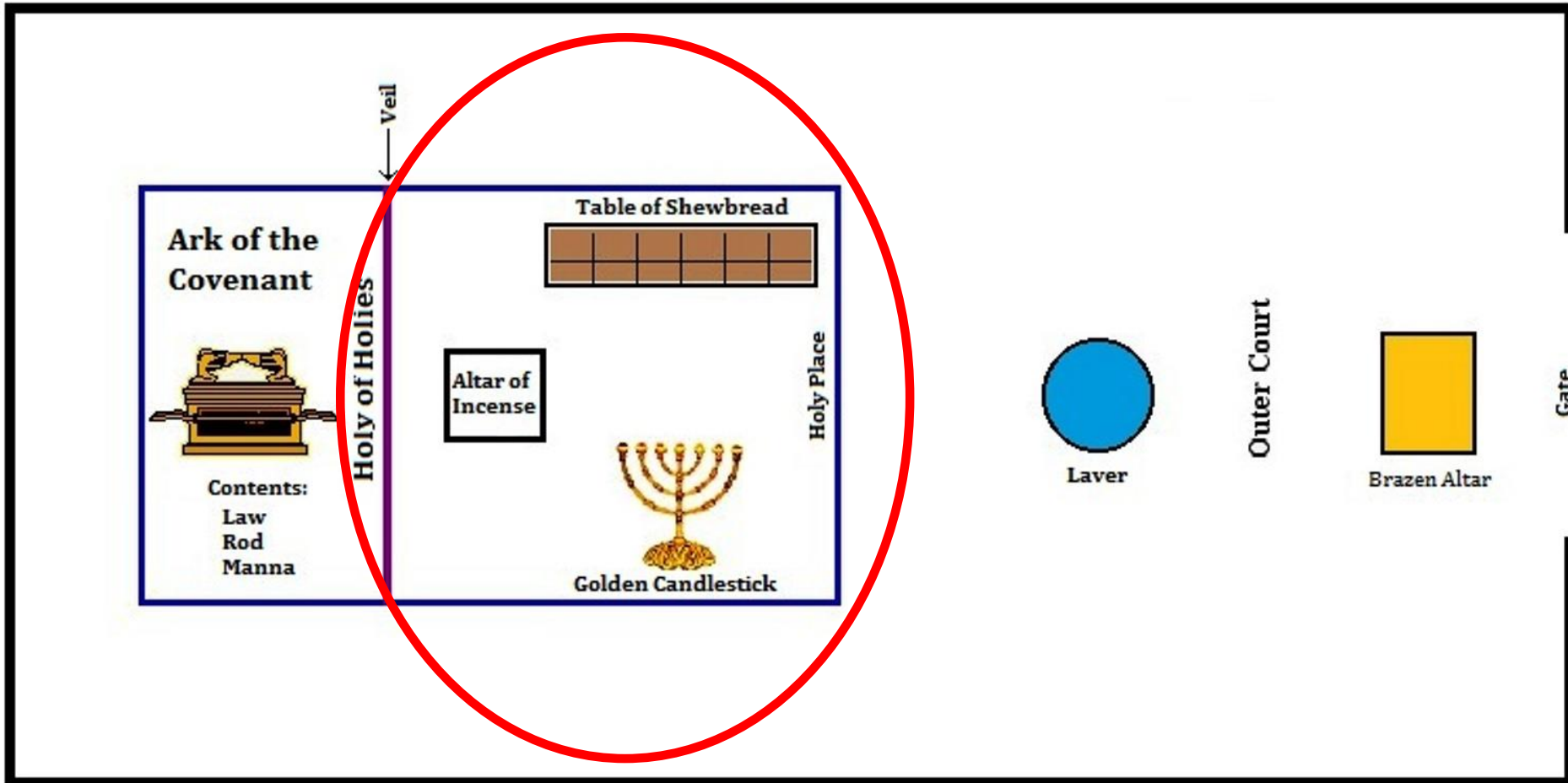

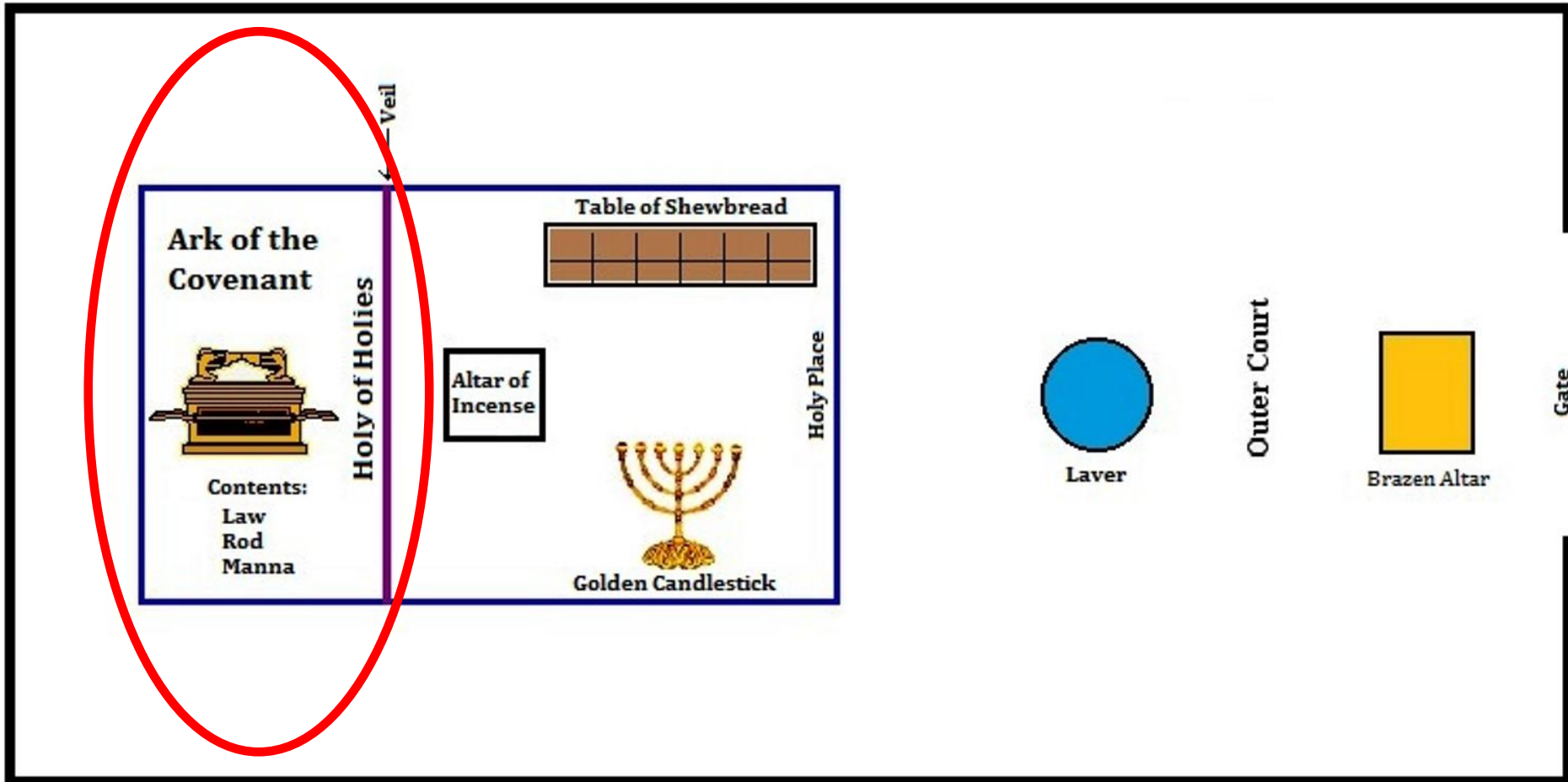


These preparations having thus been made, the priests go regularly into the first section, performing their ritual duties, (Hebrews 9:6 ESV)

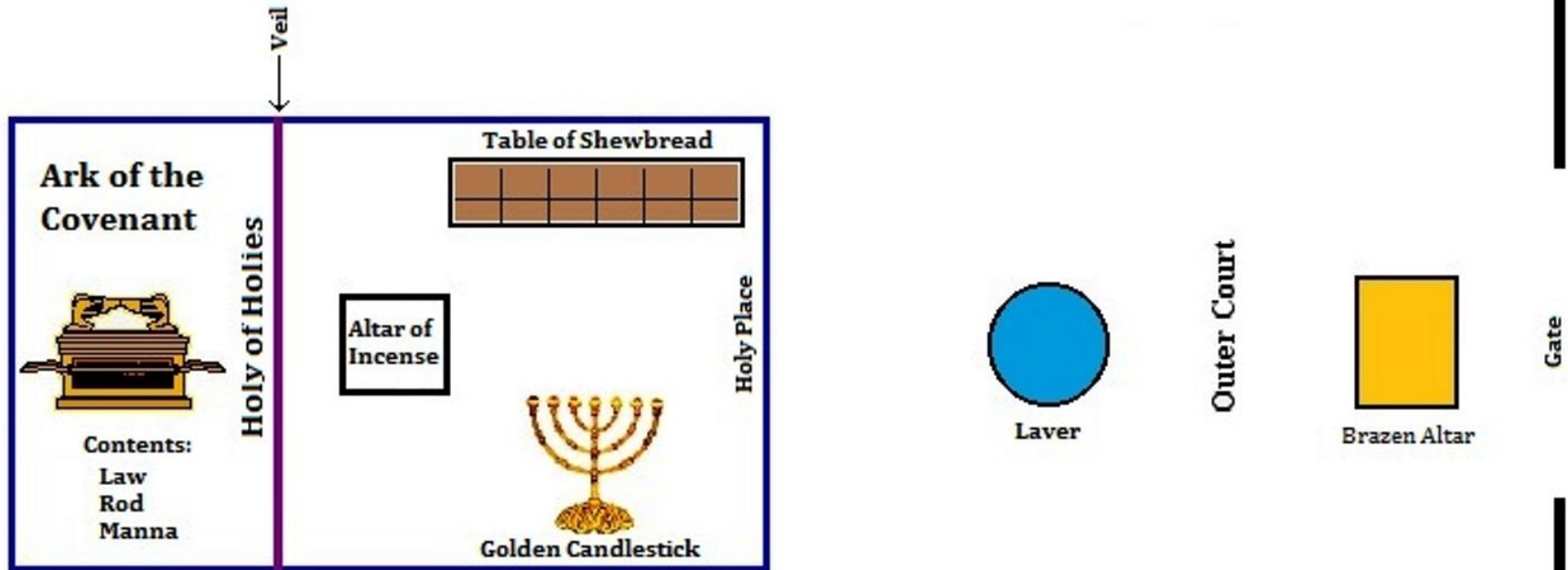

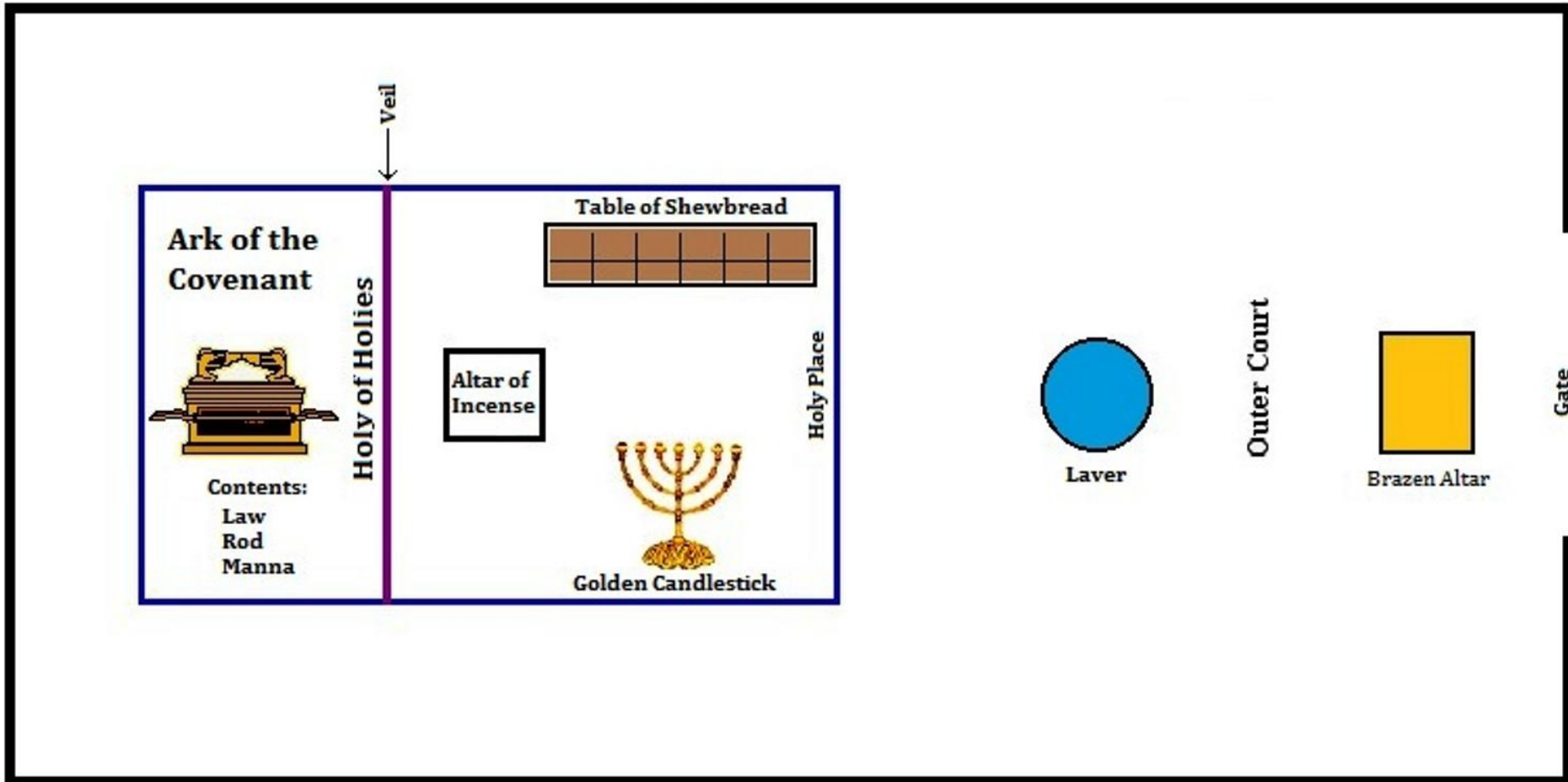

But in these sacrifices there is a **reminder** of sins every year. (Hebrews 10:3)

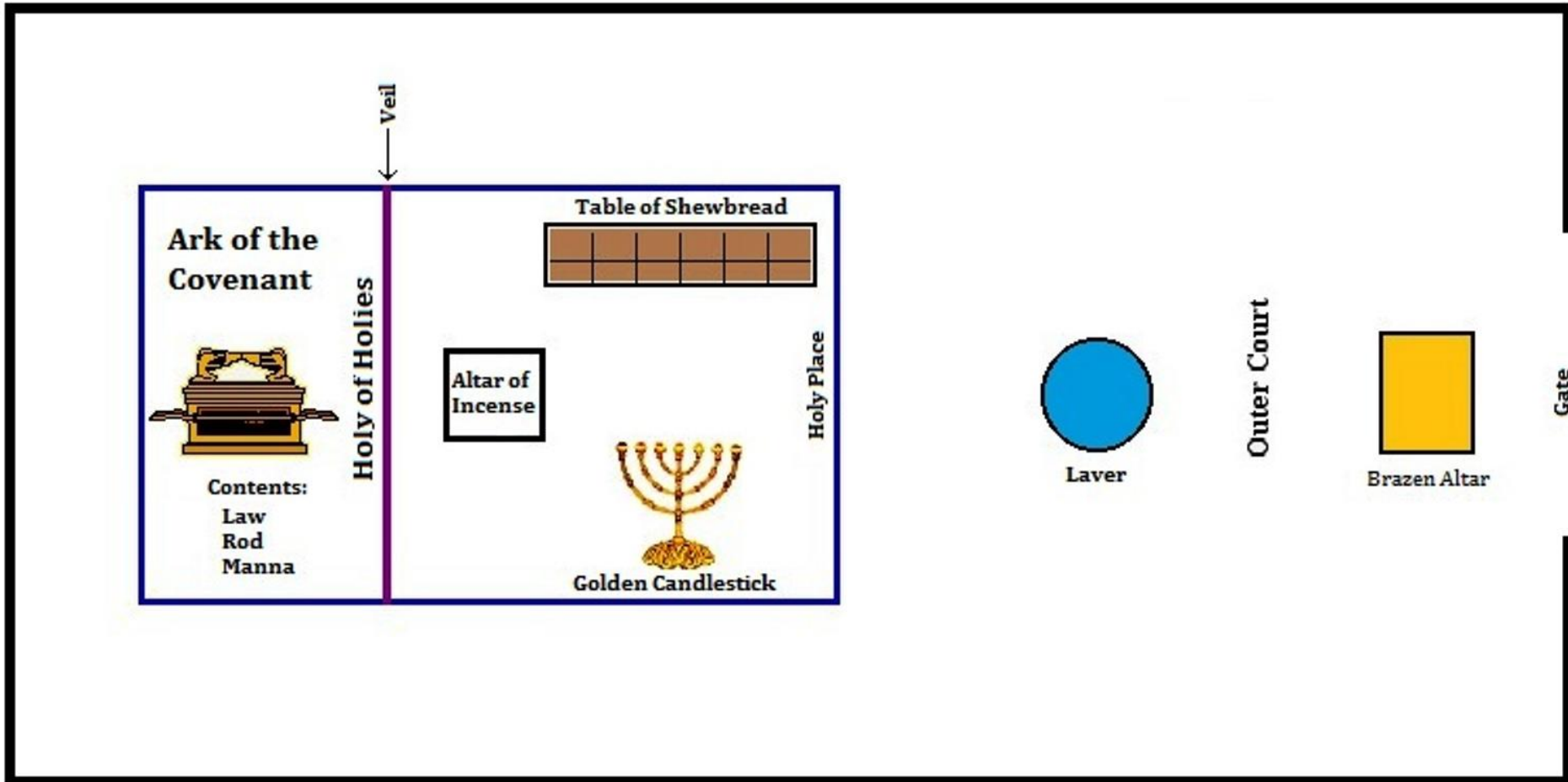

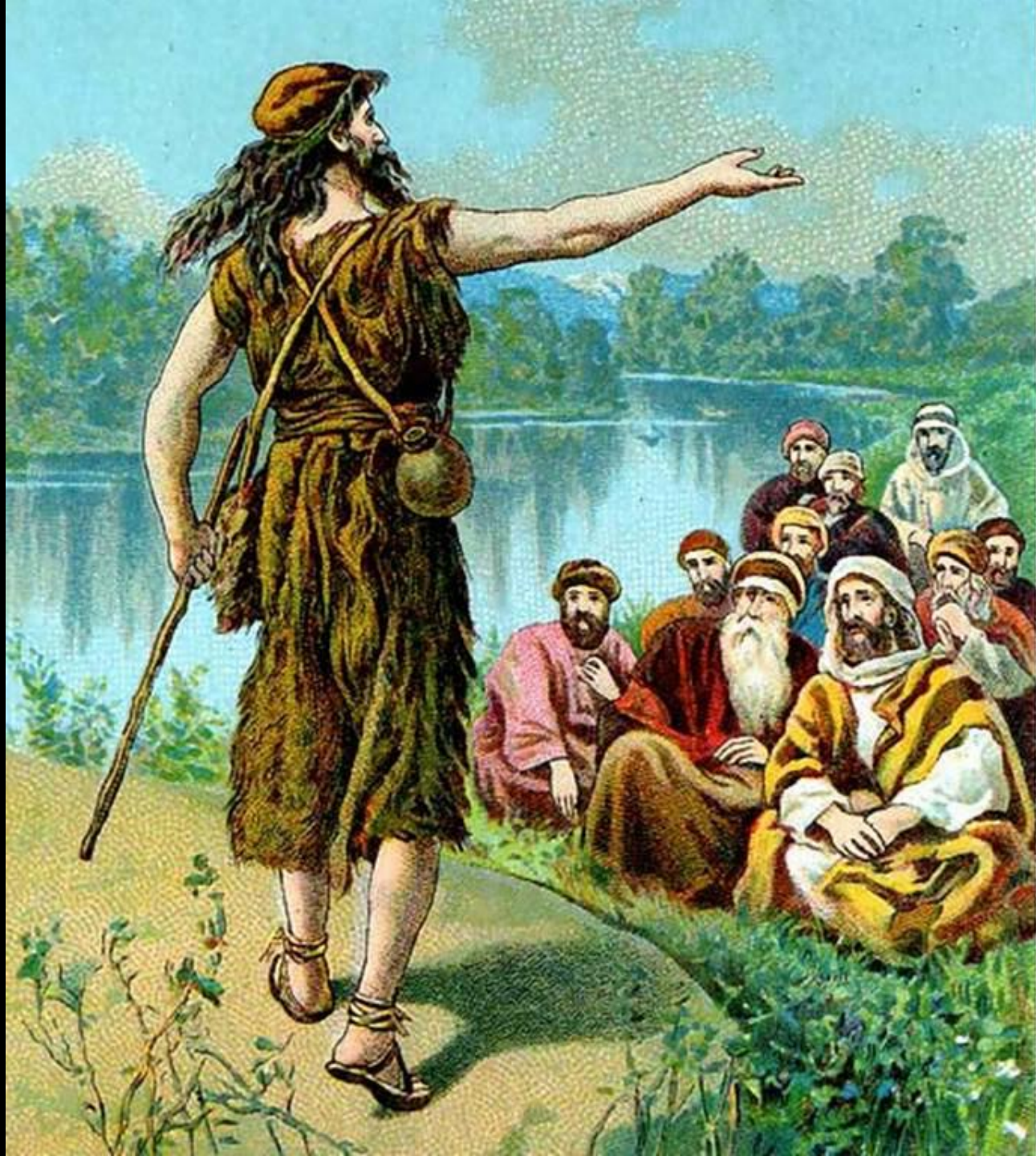
