COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT @ PUNGGOL

The Punggol Dream is turning into a reality. Thank God for the opportunity to reach out to the community in Punggol on 21 and 28 May. We had about 365 volunteers from our church visiting approximately 100 blocks of flats over the 2 Saturdays. Thank you all for participating! It was one of the largest scale community outreach efforts organized by our church in recent times. Even though it was a simple outreach, I believe it was used by God as a faith-building, love-building and church-building exercise.

The outreach was a faith-building exercise. Most of us had never done this before, and it was a step of faith to sign up and go door-to-door. I thank God that many took this step of faith to go into the unknown. I hope that members who went had their faith strengthened and will go out again in future. For me, it was a faith-building exercise to organize the outreach for the whole church. I also prayed that there would be no major problems such as residents' complaints that would hinder our efforts. Thank God that we didn't face major issues and managed to proceed with the door-to-door visits quite smoothly.

It was also a love-building exercise. Through this outreach, many of us had the chance to pair up and interact with other church members whom we didn't know. Knowing one another is the first step to loving brethren from different congregations, cultures and languages in the church. I had the privilege to be paired up with Praveen (a Telugu brother) on the first Saturday, and Carmen (a Filipino sister) on the 2nd Saturday. It allowed me to get better acquainted with the Telugu and Filipino members in Gospel Light. At the same time, through these door to door visits, our members can start to get acquainted with our neighbours in Punggol and begin to build up our love for them. Hopefully Gospel Light can become a church that loves her neighbours in the community.

Lastly, it is also a church-building exercise. I was thankful that the whole church could be involved in this exercise. It helped the church to come together and serve others. The different congregations will finally come together in Punggol when Gospel Light relocates. We should aim at becoming more integrated and grow together as one church, with the different parts fitted together nicely as a whole. Initiatives like these allow the church to move forward as one for the Lord's Kingdom.

We will have at least one more community outreach event in the 2nd half of this year. I hope you can be part of it too! Do consider other ways by which we can better reach out to the community in Punggol - be it by CG adopting some blocks of flats, reaching out the needy in the rental block, providing free medical services to the poor, etc. Together, we can be a light and salt to the community.

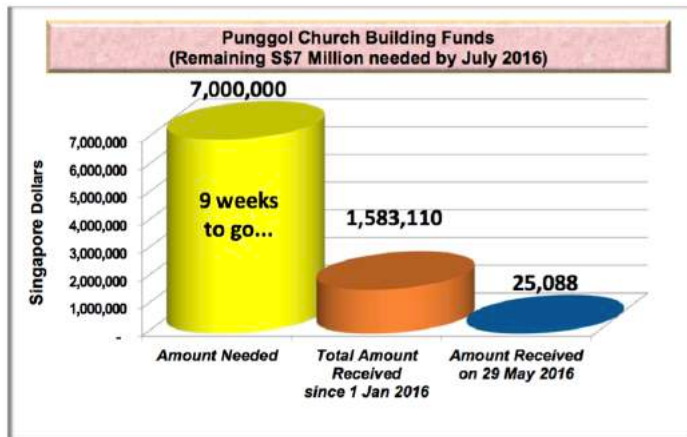
