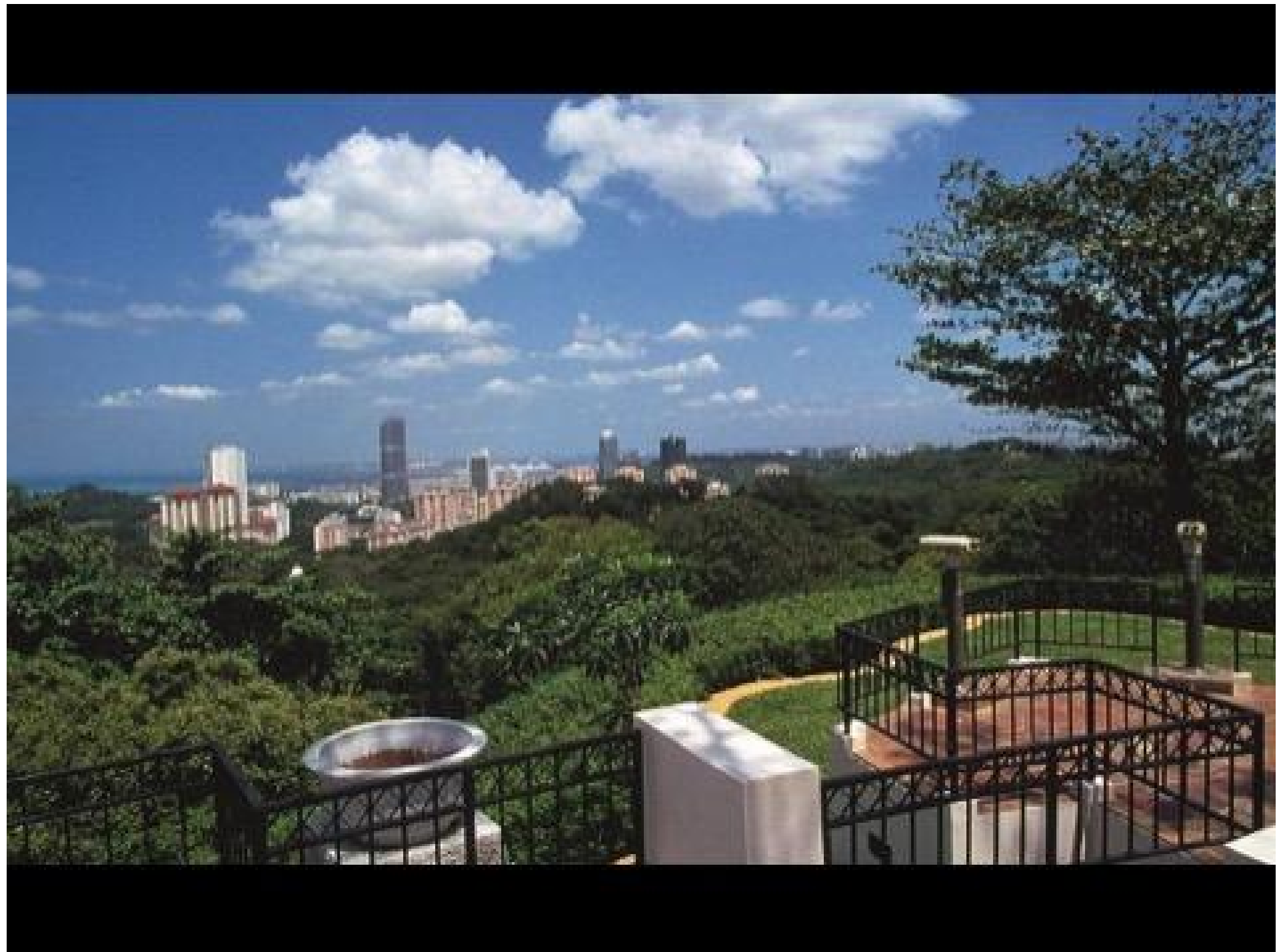




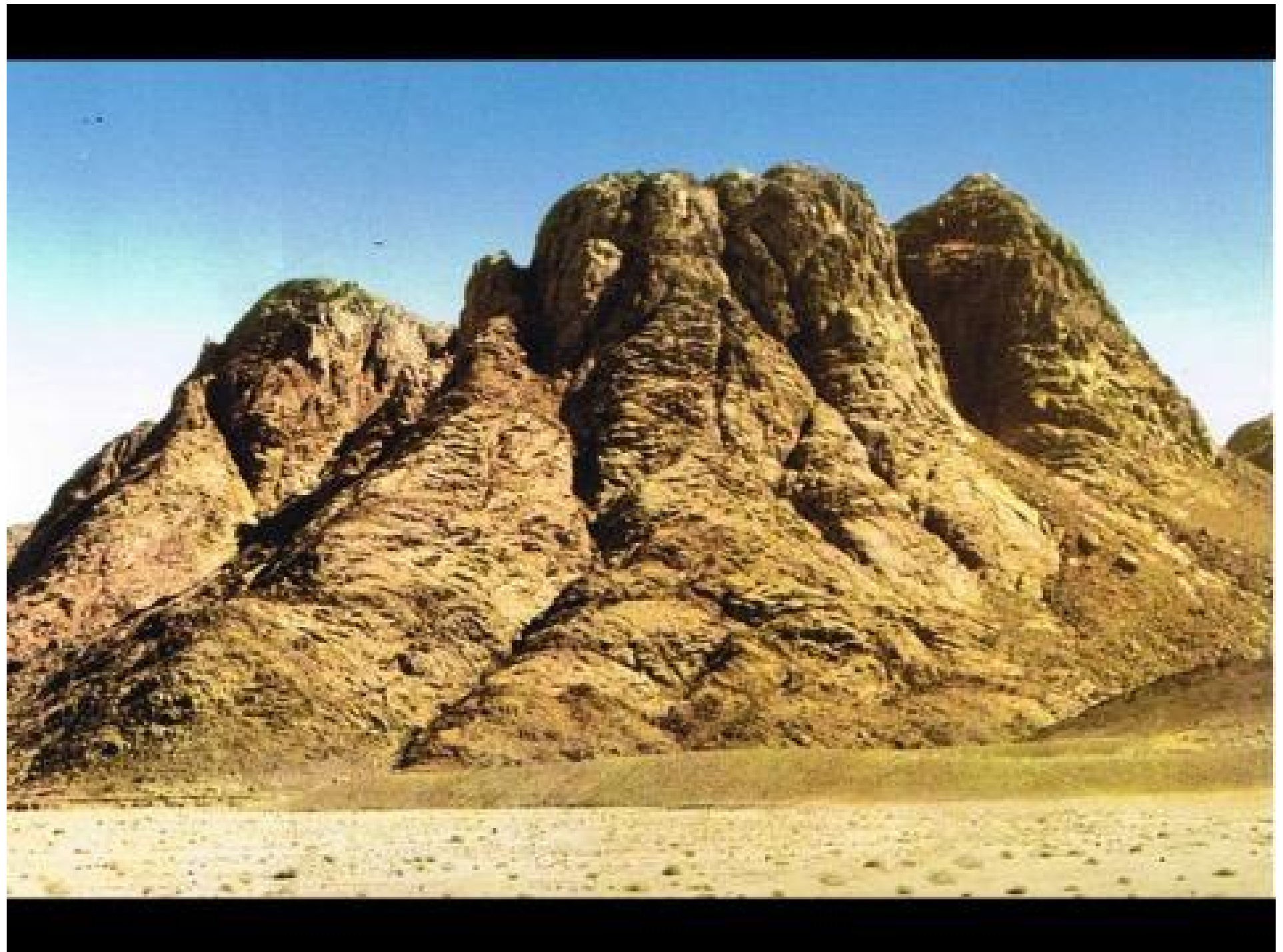

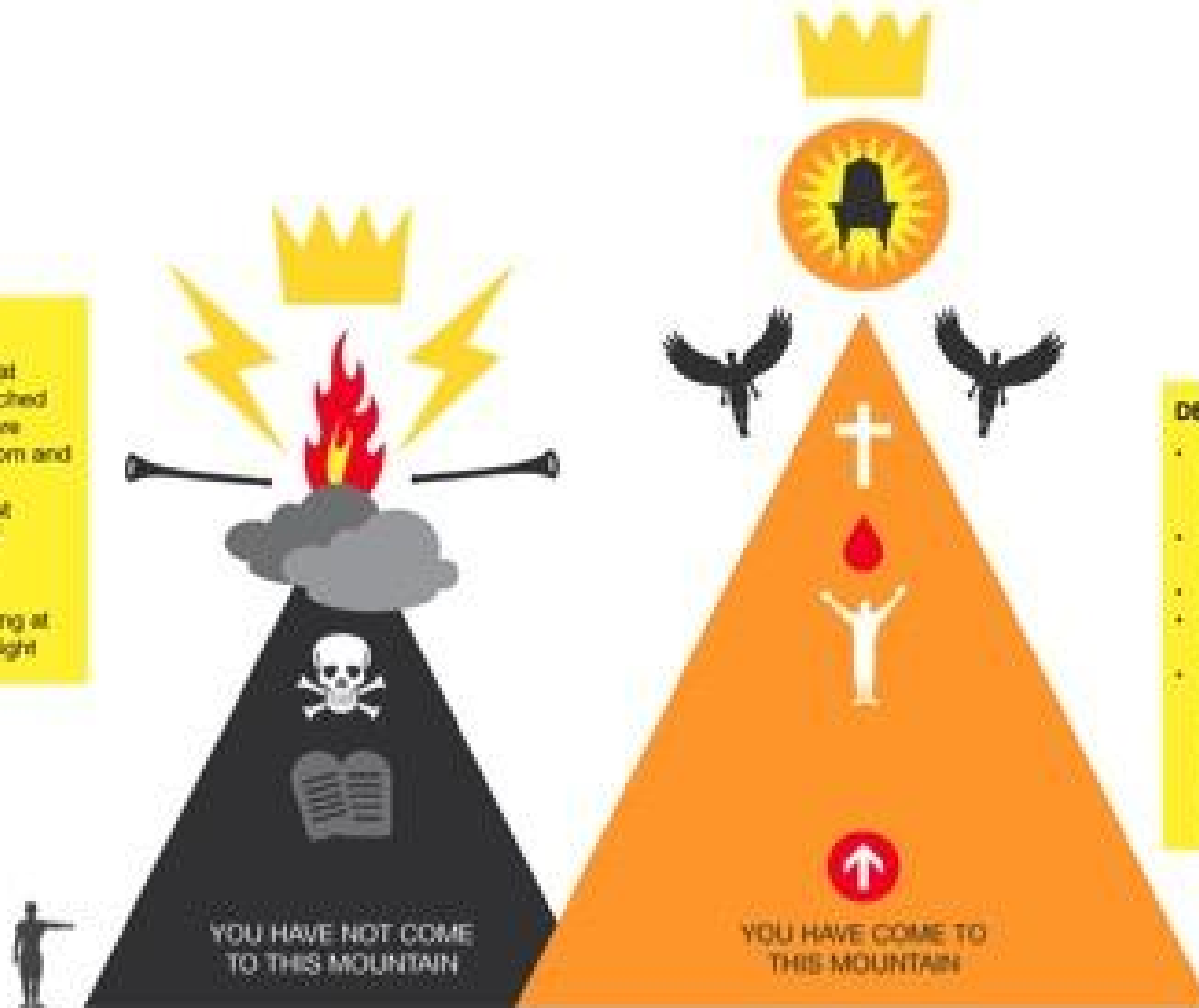

See that you do not refuse him who is speaking.

(Hebrews 12:25 ESV)

THE BOOK OF HEBREWS

See that you do not refuse him who is speaking.
For if they did not escape when they refused him
who warned them on earth, **much less will we escape**
if we reject him who warns from heaven.

(Hebrews 12:25 ESV)

At that time his voice shook the earth,
but now he has promised, **“Yet once more
I will shake not only the earth but also the heavens.”**

This phrase, “Yet once more,” indicates the removal of things that are shaken—that is, things that have been made—in order that the things that cannot be shaken may remain.

(Hebrews 12:26-27 ESV)

Therefore we must pay much closer attention to what we have heard, lest we drift away from it. For since the message declared by angels proved to be reliable, and every transgression or disobedience received a just retribution, **how shall we escape** if we neglect such a great salvation? It was declared at first by the Lord, and it was attested to us by those who heard,

(Hebrews 2:1-3 ESV)

Anyone who has set aside the law of Moses dies without mercy on the evidence of two or three witnesses. **How much worse punishment**, do you think, will be deserved by the one who has trampled underfoot the Son of God, and has profaned the blood of the covenant by which he was sanctified, and has outraged the Spirit of grace?

(Hebrews 10:28-29 ESV)

See that you do not refuse him who is speaking.

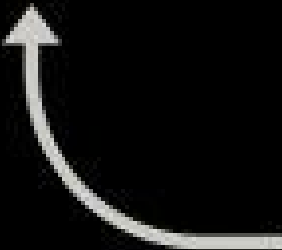
