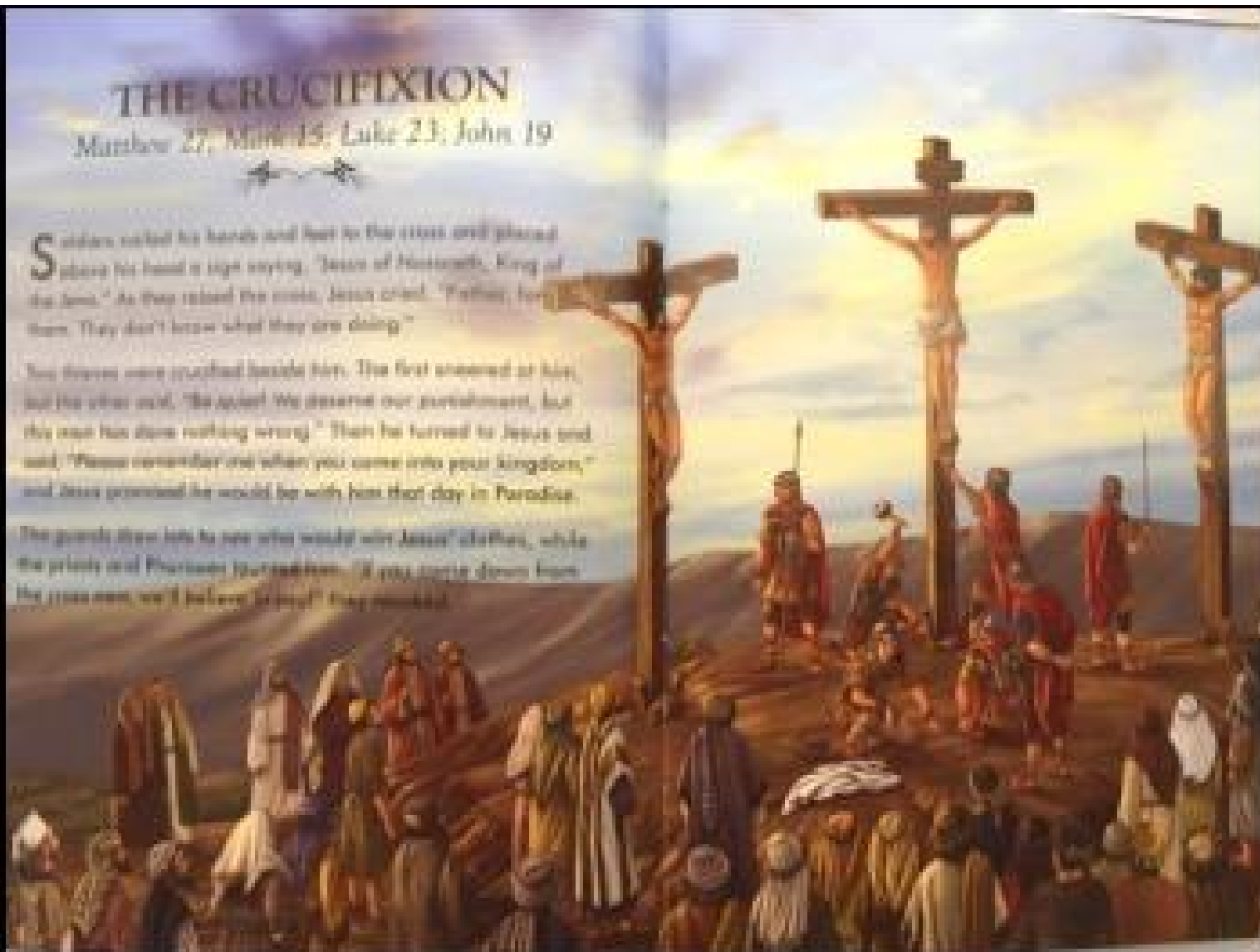
THE CRUCIFIXION


Matthew 27, Mark 15, Luke 23, John 19
