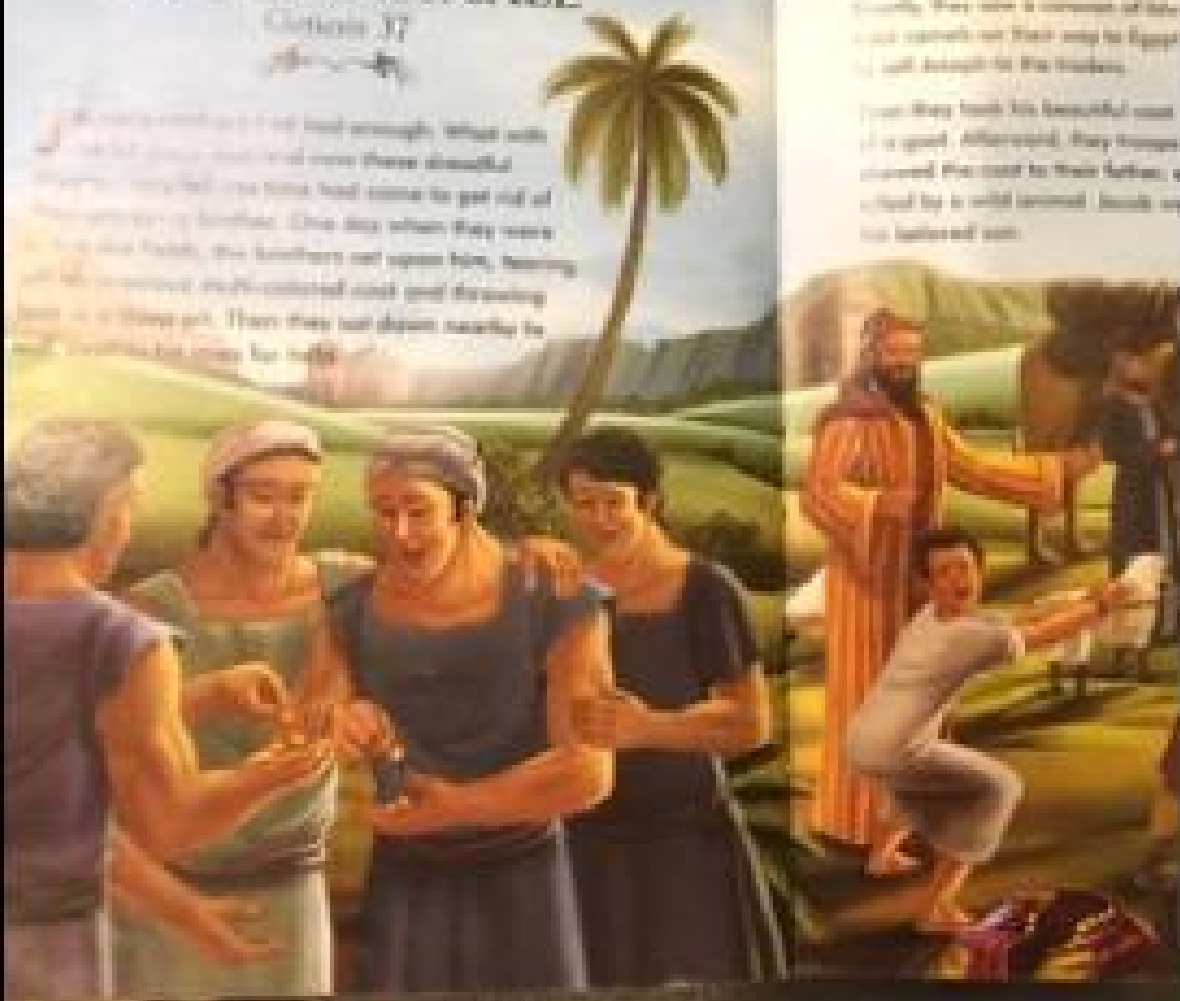
Genesis 37




