

EXPOSITORY BIBLE STUDY

Expository Bible Study is a book-by-book and verse-by-verse study of the Bible. The main objective of this ministry is life transformation to be more like Christ. The Bible is the chief authority for Christian living and as believers, we should take the time and effort to understand what God seeks to teach us through it.

Paul mentioned in Col 1:9-12, "that you may be filled with the **knowledge of his will** in all spiritual wisdom and understanding, so as to walk in a manner worthy of the Lord, fully pleasing to him: bearing fruit in every good work and increasing in the **knowledge of God**". There is no knowledge that is more instructive to life than the knowledge of God and His will through the Word of God.

Paul also charged Timothy in 2 Tim 3:10-16 to "...continue in what **you have learned** and have firmly believed, knowing from whom you **learned it**" (v. 14). He gave further emphasis in v.16 on the use of Scripture "for teaching, for reproof, for correction, and for training in righteousness, that the man of God may be complete, equipped for every good work."

Unfortunately, there are many erroneous "Christian" ideologies today that support man-made opinions and indulge carnal desires. Hence, we must be grounded in the Word of God to distinguish the genuine teachings of God from falsehood.

Some benefits of Expository Bible Study include:

- 1. General book surveys help us understand the general themes and contexts of the individual passages and
- 2. Studying Scripture verse-by-verse helps us gain a deeper understanding of what the biblical authors are trying to convey.
- 3. By applying points 1 and 2, it gives us a better understanding of the Gospel so that we will not swing to extreme beliefs (eg. Legalism or Seeker Friendly teachings), but instead have a more accurate understanding and deeper conviction of our faith.
- 4. It gives us a better understanding of who God is (theology) and what His will is for us for our life on this earth.
- 5. It will help debunk false ideologies and promises taught as man-made eisegesis (or wrong exegesis), and align us back to the biblical truths that God is trying to teach us through the Word.

While the material will cover some historical, contextual and lexicon studies, the focus will be more towards a plain literal reading, which can be achieved by the average believer.

We will begin with the book of Acts, and meetings will be weekly on Tuesday nights. It will take us about 8 – 9 months to finish Acts. Each lesson will seek to identify some life applications. Attendees are encouraged to read through each chapter of Acts prior to every lesson.
