We begin a 5-part series on "Health Screening for the Church" today. I trust that God will use these 5 weeks to help us understand His will for Gospel Light. I pray that we will all listen with attentiveness, humility and a commitment to obey. At a time when a church's size and success (in a worldly sense) are benchmarks some use in picking a church, we must not be swept along blindly but be sober and vigilant to pray and labour towards what is truly a healthy church.

Sadly, many people have decided that the local church is not so important anymore. They believe that they can practice their faith privately. They may have been disappointed by "institutionalised or organised church", church pastors, or church members. They may have even left off being part of a local church. Nevertheless, the local church is bought by the blood of Jesus and is God's plan for world-wide evangelisation and witness. The local church is God's means of grace to His people for spiritual life and growth. In fact, think about it, the local church is the only human institution that will last into eternity (even our marriages cease then)! We must have a high view of the local church as laid out in scripture. As such, I urge for your regard for this important series at the start of 2018.

This sermon series is loosely based on the book "9 Marks" by Pastor Mark Dever, Senior Pastor of Capitol Hill Baptist Church in Washington, DC. The 9 marks he selected to reflect church health are not exhaustive. There can be many more marks like prayer and missions, but these 9 marks are already worthy of our attention. For the sake of brevity, we have combined the 9 marks into 5 screening tests:

- a. Word
- b. Gospel
- c. Evangelism
- d. Membership
- e. Discipline

Every week, we will look into one screening test in our sermons. I encourage you to share and discuss in your care groups and your families what you learn in the sermons. Talk about what it means to Gospel Light as a whole, your care group, your family and for yourself. Then pray for one another and for the church. Ask God to help us obey and strive to be a healthy church for His glory.

May Gospel Light shine indeed!
