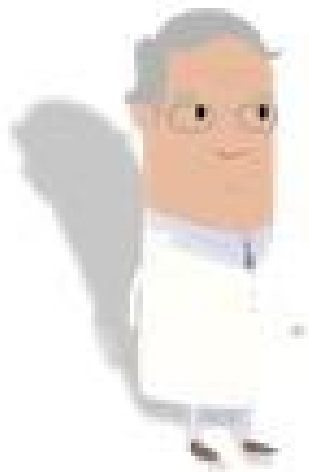


I remember sitting in a doctrinal seminar and making an observation about God from the Bible.

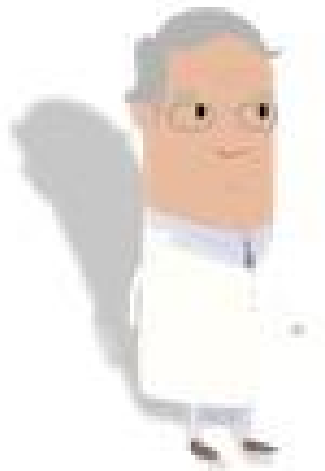




My reply was perhaps somewhat sharper than it should have been.

“Thank you, Bill,” I said, “for telling us so much about yourself, but we are concerned to know what God is really like, not simply about our own desires.”

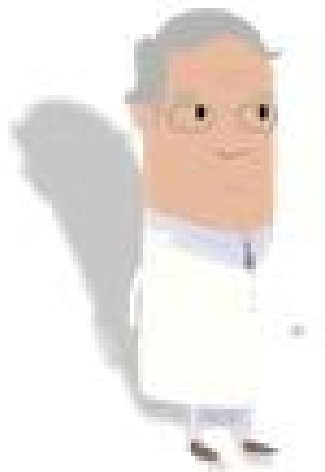
