The flames of my faith were fanned as I studied Jesus' claim that the Kingdom of Heaven was already here on Earth. I felt a sense of excitement upon realising that aspects of this Kingdom could be manifested through a believer's actions, God-willing.

Sharing this vision of a church-level ministry with Trevor Tan (Head of Community Engagement), excitement turned to joy when I realised that we were both wearing the same Kingdom-coloured lenses.

Bright Hill Home also agreed to my request (something they have not done with any other organisation) and proposed we come on the one day and time they most needed help-Sunday morning.

The residents were so pleased to see us when we came. While there, we threw balls with them, did art and craft, hosted magic shows, took them to the roof top garden, and asked about their lives past and present. These connections have enabled us to invite and wheel them across the street to join us at service to hear the word of God and fellowship with us. Whilst doing good work does not result in Salvation, this experience has been life-transforming for me. It has taught me to be sensitive to the Holy Spirit, and that Grace received results in a desire to share that Grace.
