He believes God has His purpose for his sufferings... and though He may not take it away, He will grant strength to cope...”



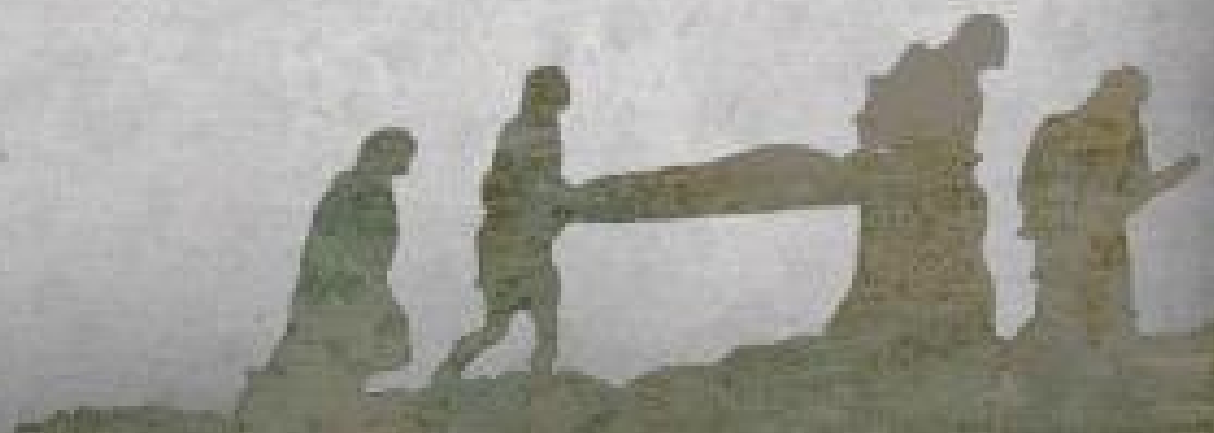

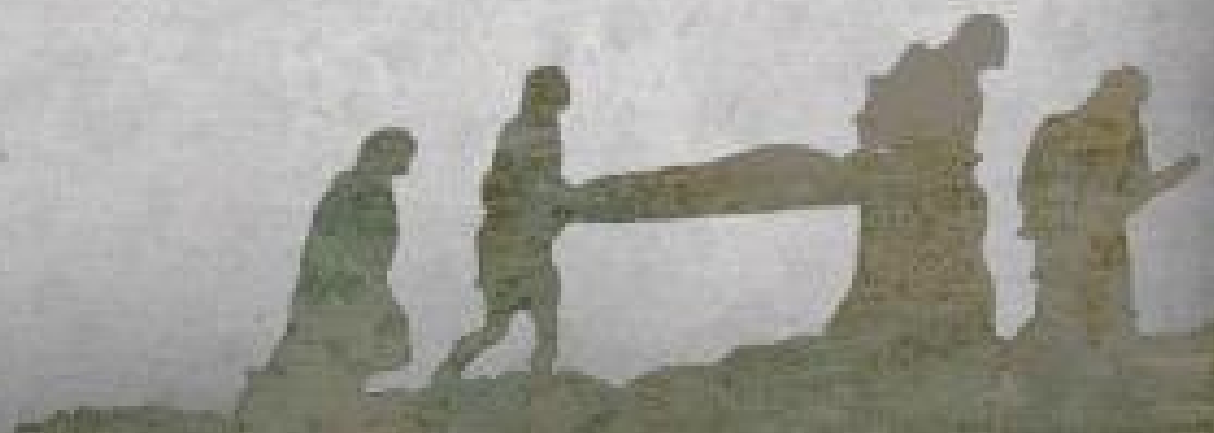

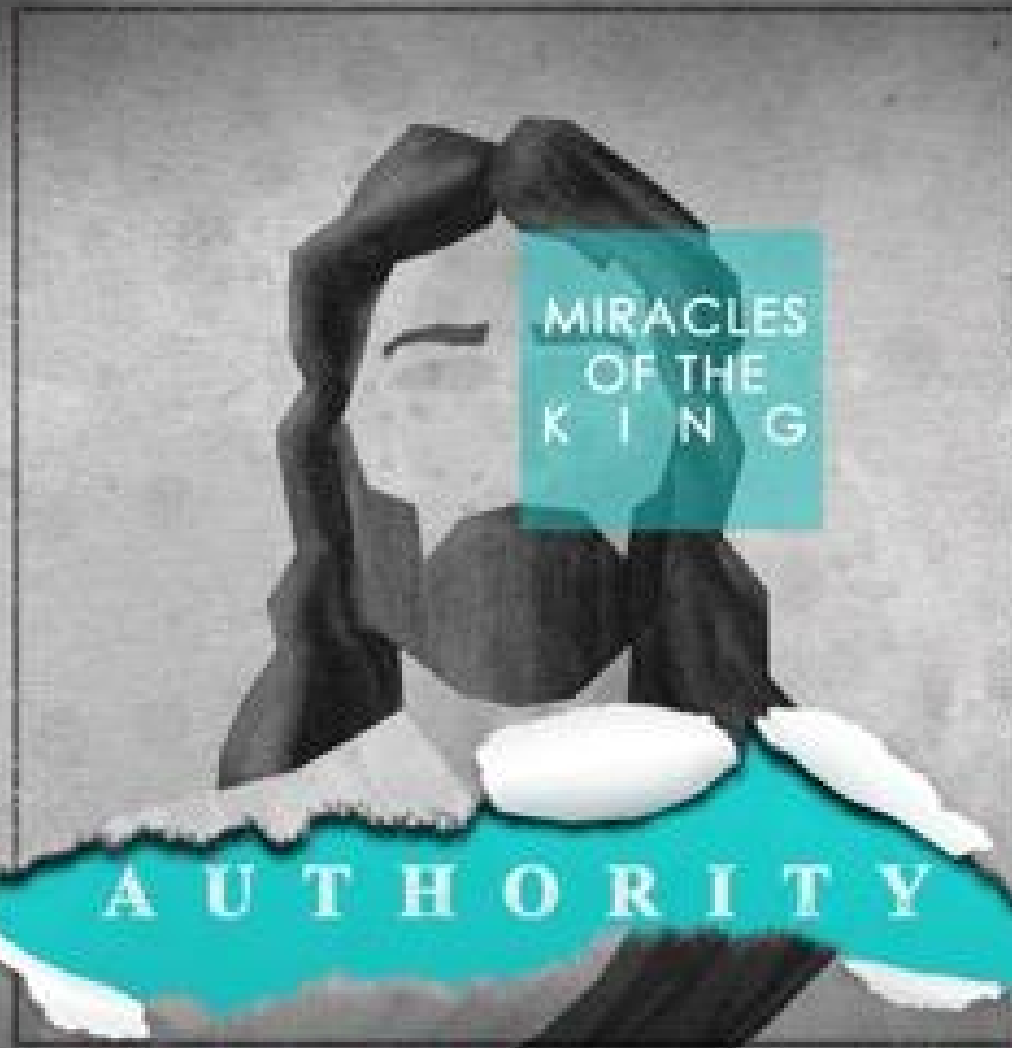
