All the above are good news indeed but they are of a temporal nature. Those things don't matter when one is no longer alive. The Good News you need to know is one of eternal consequence.

The Bible tells us, "These things I have written to you who believe in the name of the Son of God, that you may know that you have eternal life, and that you may continue to believe in the name of the Son of God." - 1 John 5:13

The Good News in a nutshell is; God loves you and He would like you to have the peace and joy in your heart to know all your mistakes or sins can be forgiven and heaven can be your eternal home.

The **PROBLEM** of Sin

"But your iniquities have separated you from your God; And your sins have hidden His face from you, So that He will not hear."
- Isaiah 59:2

"for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God," - Romans 3:23

"For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord." - Romans 6:23

To sin means "to miss the mark or to wander from the path of uprightness and honor, to do or go wrong.

The **PENALTY** of Sin

The **PAYMENT** of Sin

"God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us." - Romans 5:8

"For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life." - John 3:16

"The Lord is not slack concerning His promise, as some count slackness, but is longsuffering toward us, not willing that any should perish but that all should come to repentance." - 2 Peter 3:9

The Bible tells us God is Love – 1 John 4:8; we are created in His love and we enjoy free will- the ability to make decisions, because of His love. It is also His love for us that prompted Him to sacrifice His Son, Jesus Christ for us.

It is never God's intention to send anyone to hell. God showed His love toward us by instead of judging us for our sins; He directed His judgment on His Son, Jesus Christ instead.

The Bible tells us Jesus Christ is the Son of God who humbled Himself and willingly become the perfect man whose sole purpose is to be the payment for the sins of the world.

God in His infinite wisdom knows there is nothing we can do that can remove sin in our life or help us on our way to Heaven, which is why He did it for us through Jesus Christ, His Son.

Jesus Christ came to pay a debt (of sin) He did not owe because we owed a debt (of sin) we could not pay!

At the end of His life, Jesus Christ was beaten, tortured and nailed to a cross where His blood was shed. On the cross before He died, Jesus said, "It is finished!" – John 19:30, meaning He has accomplished what He came to do, which is to be the payment for all our sins.

The Bible tells us "the blood of Jesus Christ His Son cleanses us from all sin." - 1 John 1:7

It was not the nails driven by the Roman soldiers that held Jesus to the cross but rather His love for us that held Him to the cross. Through His death, burial and resurrection, we can be restored to an intimate and loving relationship with God and spend eternity with Jesus in heaven.

Throughout history, there have been heroic men and women who died for their family, country and friends. The difference between Jesus Christ and those people is that those men stay dead but the Bible tells us Jesus Christ rose again 3 days after His death. His resurrection authenticates who He truly is, the Son of God.
