RACIAL HARMONY CARNIVAL

This is an annual event in July organized by the Punggol North Racial & Religious Harmony committee to promote neighbourliness, as well as racial and religious harmony.

As a church planted by God in Punggol, we want to be a church ‘for Punggol’. This event provides the platform for us to connect with the Punggol North community, and to tell them about Gospel Light. The event expects to attract some 10,000 residents living along Punggol Field.

Last year, our Telugu brothers distributed 1,350 cups of tamarind rice and connected with more than 130 families. The balloon sculpturing team anchored by the Children Ministry gave away some 750 balloons. Our Filipino brethren gave away 300-plus ice candy sticks. Members from various ministries - Conversational English, Club 39, Ping Pong Ministry, Morning Exercise, and ShineKidz (after school care) - were present to provide more information about the different outreaches.

This year, with bigger booth space, we want to raise the awareness of our new community engagement programs like Urban Farming@Gospellight, Breakfast@Gospellight and events like Mid-Autumn celebrations. These outreach efforts provide opportunities for our members to befriend residents and to reach the lost for Christ!

Volunteer as a Gospel Light ambassador at this event and play your part in fulfilling the call to ‘Go for Christ’. The carnival is on Sunday, July 15 from 2pm to 9pm, at Blocks 173 to 175C along Punggol Field. A training and briefing session for all GLCC volunteers will be held on Sunday, July 8.
