Guidelines for Ethics in the Workplace

When faithfulness is not clear:

- 1. What clear Biblical commands or principles apply?
- 2. What does your conscience say? Remember:
 - a. It's generally unsafe to violate your conscience.
 - b. Your conscience may be wrong. It might be seared (1 Timothy 4:2); it might need to be educated (1 Corinthians 8:7).
 - c. We must protect the consciences of others (1 Corinthians 8:12).
- 3. What good opportunities are at stake?
- 4. How will different courses of action make Christ attractive? (Titus 2:10)

- 6. What advice to Christians at work give you?
