RACIAL HARMONY CARNIVAL 2018

Last Sunday, Gospel Light participated in the Punggol North Racial Harmony Street Parade cum Family Carnival for the third year running. With an estimated turn out of 10,000 residents, we are glad that more than 130 volunteers from Gospel Light participated as ambassadors and helpers.

Our theme was **“Connecting With You”**, and two large banners prepared by the Communications team showcased our community engagement efforts. The booth space allocated to us was double that of last year, allowing 3 ministries and 9 community engagement platforms to be represented. Urban Farming and Crafts4Life, the newest kids on the block, drew the most attention from residents. More than 70 indicated interest for the two programs.

Our Telugu brothers gave away 2,000 bowls of Tamarind Rice, and our Filipino team distributed 500 bowls of porridge. **More than 40 balloon sculptors from Children’s Ministry and various Care Groups** made over 1,200 sculptures for kids, who all waited eagerly to receive their unique creations. Games like Speed Stax by ShineKidz and Bingo by the Conversational English ministry attracted many young participants and their parents. Almost 1,000 brochure packs about our community engagement platforms were distributed.

EXPOSITORY BIBLE STUDY

In Acts 24, Tertullus, the lawyer who represented the Sanhedrin, brought three charges against Paul to Felix, the governor. He alleged that Paul was a troublemaker, that he was a ringleader of the Nazarene sect and that he tried to desecrate the temple. In defence, Paul contended that he worshipped the God of his fathers, he believed in the teachings of the Old Testament, he had the same hope in God as the accusers did, and he always tried to have a clear conscience before God. After hearing both sides, Felix did not make any judgment on the matter and kept Paul in custody for two years. Acts 24 teaches us the importance of living a life of integrity by speaking the truth in every situation, by living in line with Scripture and by keeping a blameless conscience before God and men.
