





sea. He meant to pass by them.

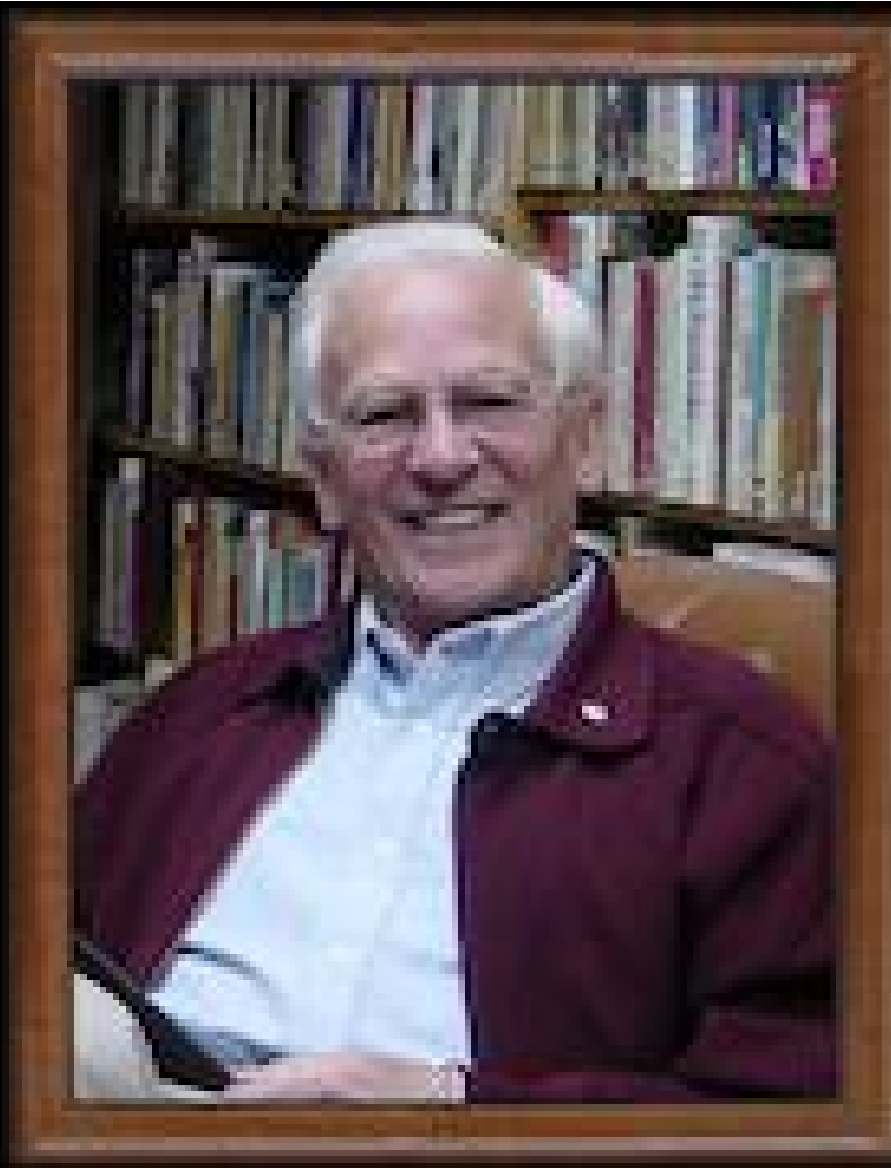
