This world is filled with people living under the enemy's strongholds, sin's bondage, and self-righteous mind-sets. Let us trust God and do our part by faithfully walking into their lives with loving obedience and the Holy Spirit's empowerment. No satisfaction is greater than obeying the gospel and proclaiming Christ to the nations.
