THE TEN COMMANDMENTS

Exodus 19-20

"You shall not murder.

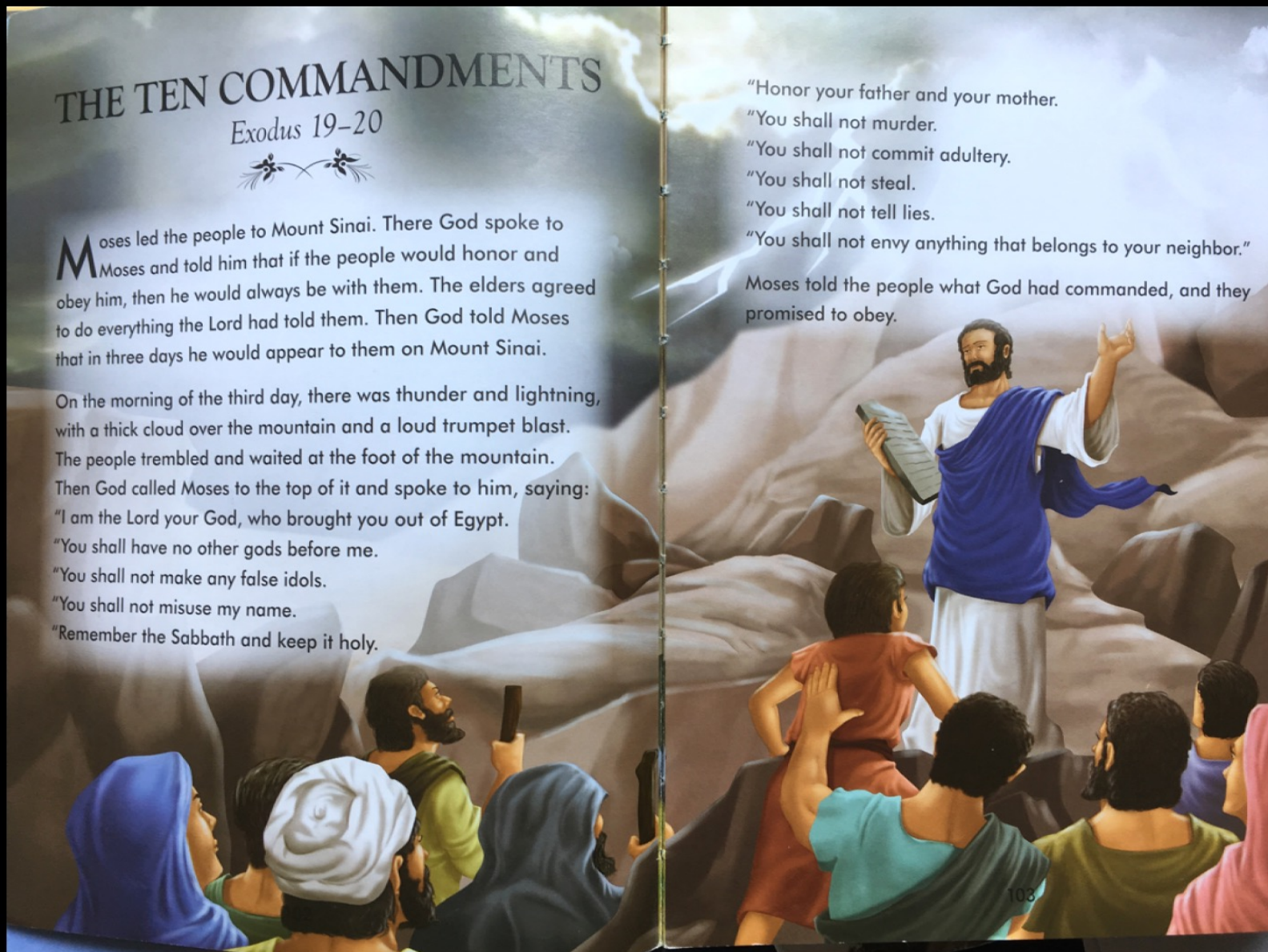
"You shall not commit adultery.


