Our Biggest Needs in Covid-19

This year has also presented very unique challenges as the world faces the COVID-19 pandemic. As we teach the youths about obeying our authorities and obeying God, we ourselves have to adapt to new and evolving government regulations. As all of our on-site services are currently suspended, we have moved to online platforms to minister to the youths through the Care Group Ministry. Currently, most youths are meeting for fellowship via Zoom on Saturdays to share about their lives and how God is teaching them in this season. We are also equipping the Care Group Leaders, so they can teach and guide their members in a study on the Book of James.

As the gospels state, the harvest is plenteous but labourers few. We have a significant need for more committed and mature labourers, who are willing to invest their time in imparting truth and the gospel. Journeying with youths can be tiring and difficult, but we are trusting the Lord of the Harvest to send forth His workers.

We pray for a spirit of unity, that our youths will not be discouraged by the current social distancing but drawn all the more to true fellowship!
