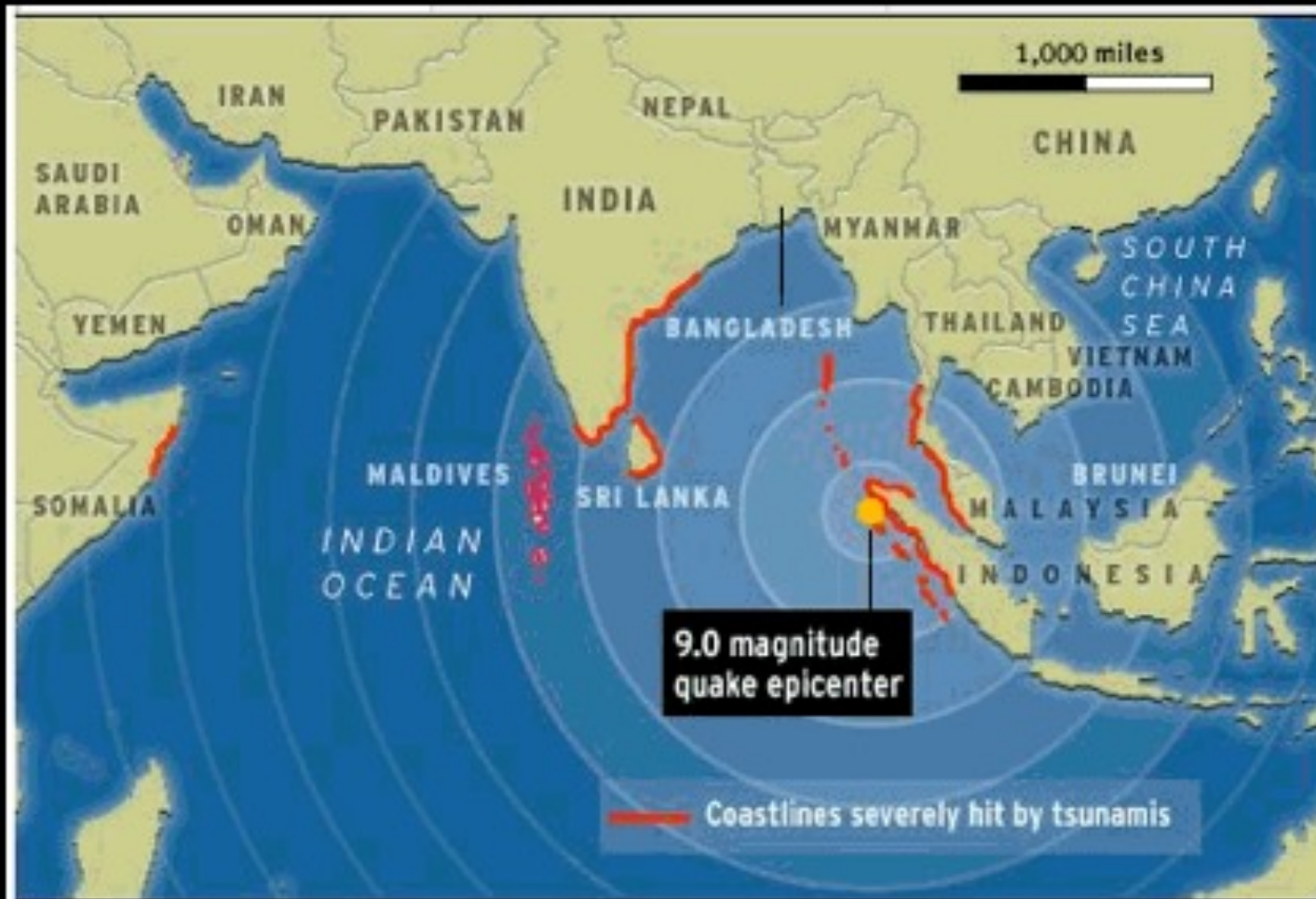

Matthew 24:37

Matthew 24:38–39
