but for those who are **self-seeking and do not obey the truth**, but obey unrighteousness, there will be wrath and fury.



1 Timothy 5:8


But if anyone does **not provide** for his relatives,

and then come and offer your gift.






No one can serve two masters...




Matthew 6:24

You cannot serve God and money.





and where thieves do not break in and steal.




