HOPEFUL IN TRIALS

We are in an unprecedented period due to the COVID-19 pandemic. You may have lost a loved one and wished you could have done a little more for this person whom you cared about dearly. You could even be losing hope over a relationship that is in a precarious position. But there is a reason for the trials of this season.

I remember the story of the butterfly as it moves through four stages: from egg, to larva, then pupa, before becoming a beautiful butterfly. At the third stage, the pupa needs to break through the hard shell of the cocoon. A small



boy, seeing the pupa struggling through the cocoon, thought he would do the butterfly a favour by cutting the end of the cocoon with a pair of scissors. However, the pupa emerged, fell to the ground, and was unable to fly. The pupa needed to struggle through the hard cocoon to build strength for its wings, and emerge as a flying butterfly. Likewise, our trials are moments God uses to build strength and resilience for the larger part of our lives.

We are reminded in Romans 12:12: "Rejoice in hope, be patient in tribulation, be constant in praver."

As children of God, we can be joyful in hope, because our hope is in Christ, who is the basis of our rejoicing (1 Peter 1:6-9). In affliction, we are reminded to be patient. Most of all, we can come to our Heavenly Father who knows what we are going through. Thus, we should continue in prayer. Before we pray for God to deliver us from the trial, we should first ask God what lessons we can learn through the trials.
