4 QUESTIONS WITH PASTOR JASON

1) What are some important lessons the church can learn from Covid-19?

Covid-19 caught us by surprise. But it is also a classroom of lessons from God:

- 1. Life is hard, God is good, and we must trust and obey.
- 2. People may be house-bound, but the Word of God is not bound!
- 3. Pestilences are God's warning to a sinful world. But they are also a gracious wake-up call to repent and believe the gospel.

2) What strengths/weaknesses do you think this virus exposed in our church?

The virus is like a double-edged sword. It shows up (for either good or bad):

- 1. The over-dependence on mass gatherings, and the wisdom of doing life-on-life discipleship with a few good men (or women).
- 2. The stripping away of "frills" and "paraphernalia", to have a more wholesome focus on the word of God in all worship services.
- 3. The fault lines in our homes, or the strength of our family ties.

3) Apart from lifting restrictions, what are other reasons people may be slow in returning to church?

I fear people will get too used to the comfort and convenience of their homes, and be reluctant to have face-to-face human interactions even when it is safe to do so.

Whilst online means are a good bridge for now, this will not hold up forever. I believe this is still workable today because of all the social or relational capital we've built up over the years, when we had fellowship with one another face-to-face. Forsaking physical meet-ups and fellowship over the long term will undermine our gospel bonds if we are not careful.

4) What is your prayer for the remainder of 2020?

I pray very much the same things I've been praying most of the time:

- 1. That we will drink in, live out and give out the gospel.
- 2. That we will be more and more like the "Acts Church for Today."
- 3. That God will do for us what Paul prayed for in Eph 3:14-21
- 4. That we will come forth better, purer, and stronger.
