and who called me by his grace,

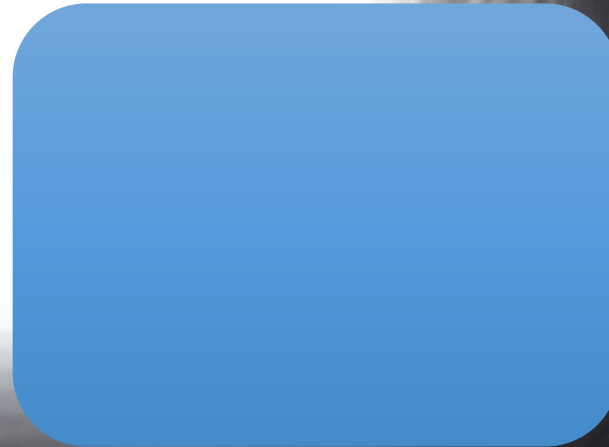
¹⁶ was pleased to reveal his Son to me,

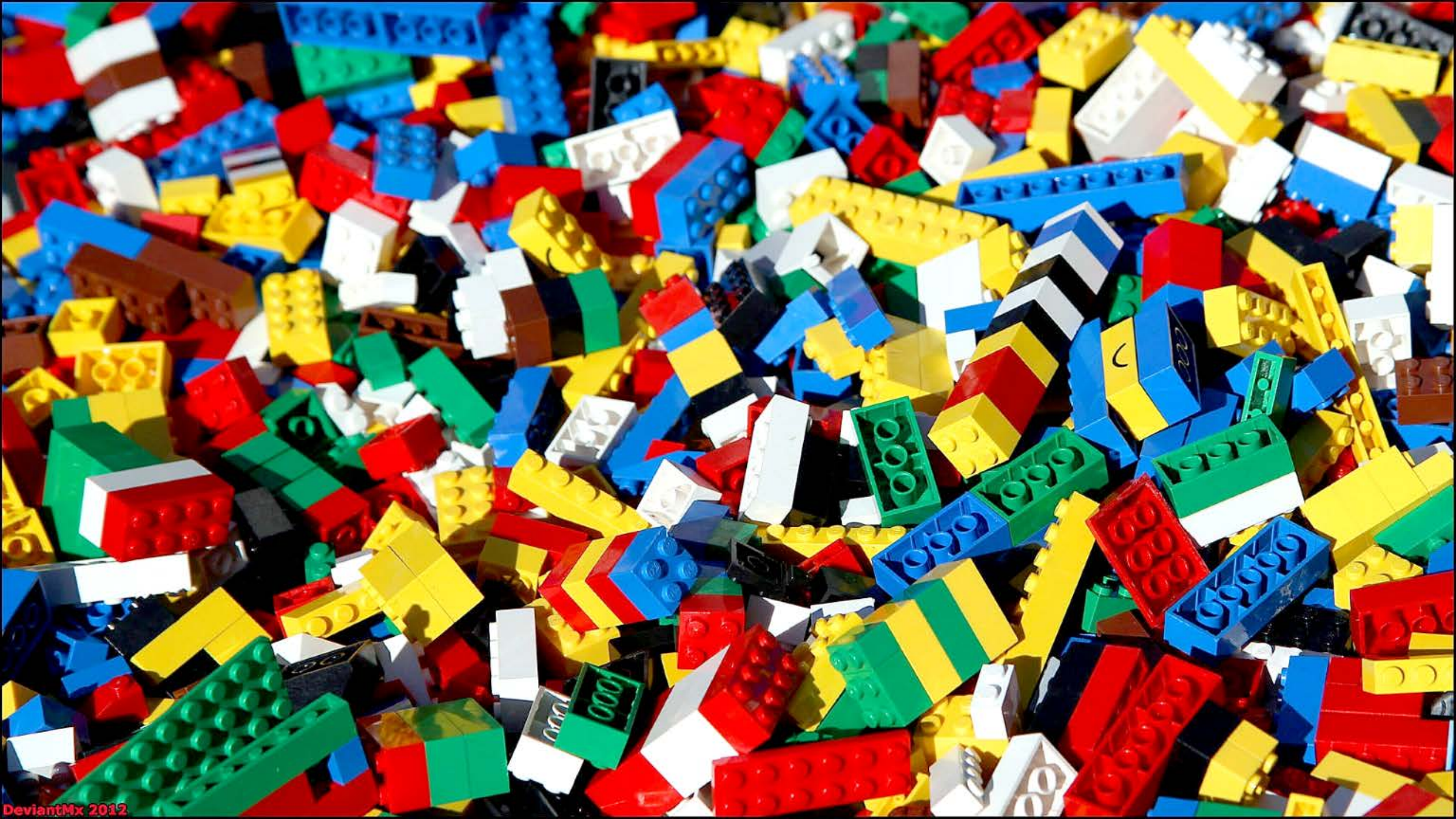
