THE GOSPEL IN COMMUNITY

For many years, being a Christian for me meant going to church on Sundays, sitting alone, feeling guilty, asking for forgiveness, and leaving immediately after service. Each week, I would try hard not to sin, out of fear of punishment, but still end up sinning. There was little joy, little peace, and certainly little hope for living a victorious life in Christ.

All that started to change when I joined a Care Group (CG). At first, I was hesitant. Giving up two Fridays a month to join a CG seemed like a big sacrifice, with few benefits. How wrong I was. "Most often, growth happens through deep relationships and in communities where the implications of the gospel are worked out cognitively and worked in practically."

Fellowshipping with other believers, I started to know and experience why God calls us to worship in community. (And let us consider how to stir up one another to love and good works, not neglecting to meet together, as is the habit of some, but encouraging one another. - Hebrews 10:24-25). As we delved deeper into God's Word, applied it to our daily lives, and prayed for one another, my heart was transformed from the inside out. No longer was it head knowledge, but true life change. Christianity was not simply a part of my life, but became central and core to who I was.

Being part of a CG is much more than being part of another social group. It is the only place I can comfortably share my fears and desires knowing I will not be judged, but prayed for. "Therefore, confess your sins to one another and pray for one another, that you may be healed..." James 5:16

American pastor and bestselling author Timothy Kelller puts it well in his book "Center Church":

"Accordingly, the chief way in which we should disciple people (or, if you prefer, to form them spiritually) is through community. Growth in grace, wisdom, and character does not happen primarily in classes and instruction, through large worship gatherings, or even in solitude. Most often, growth happens through deep relationships and in communities where the implications of the gospel are worked out cognitively and worked in practically—in ways no other setting or venue can afford. The essence of becoming a disciple is, to put it colloquially, becoming like the people we hang out with the most. Just as the single most formative experience in our lives is our membership in a nuclear family, so the main way we grow in grace and holiness is through deep involvement in the family of God. Christian community is more than just a supportive fellowship; it is an alternate society. And it is through this alternate human society that God shapes us into who and what we are."

If you are not yet in a CG, may God lead you to one today!
