

DON'T BE A LONE ZEBRA

I once watched a National Geographic documentary about how lions hunt. They would spend time stalking a herd of zebras, picking out the weakest or the sickest, before scattering the herd and attacking their target. Scripture tells us that the Devil prowls around like a roaring lion, seeking whom he may devour (1 Pet 5:8). Therefore, Scripture also commands us to join a gathering of the saints, that is, a local church (Heb 10:15). The local church is the herd of God's people. But unlike zebras, we do not forsake the weak and the sick. To intentionally refuse to join the local church is akin to a zebra which intentionally stands apart from the herd. This would make us easy prey for the Devil and the world.



No Christian can survive on his own, and though everyone is saved by his own faith, God has promised to save His people through His church. After all, the local church is where the Word is preached, the gospel is proclaimed, and where Christ lovingly disciples His people.

In Gospel Light, the Care Group (CG) is the means by which members have fellowship and participate in a community within the church. In a CG, you will find fellow brothers and sisters who love God and His people, as well as seek to know and serve Him more. You will learn Scripture and about how it changes one's life, as well as have opportunities to love and serve your CG mates. You will find spiritual support through life - both in joyful and sorrowful times - and will also be able to provide similar support when others need it. It is in the CG where you will find a *family* in the truest sense of the word, worshipping your Father through your Brother in your Comforter with your other brothers and sisters.

Though the CG is no substitute for corporate worship on the Lord's Day, we urge you to find a CG to get plugged into church life. There are 51 CGs that meet regularly in various parts of Singapore. Meet other believers and worship with them on Sunday, then invest in each other's lives from Monday to Saturday. It truly is wonderful to belong to the local church.

If you don't like being around God's people on earth, I have bad news for you, friend. Heaven will be an eternity spent with God's people, worshipping the Father, Son, and Spirit. So do join a CG – you'll find that it will bless you tremendously. Honour everyone, love the local church (1 Pet 2:17). Don't be like that zebra!
