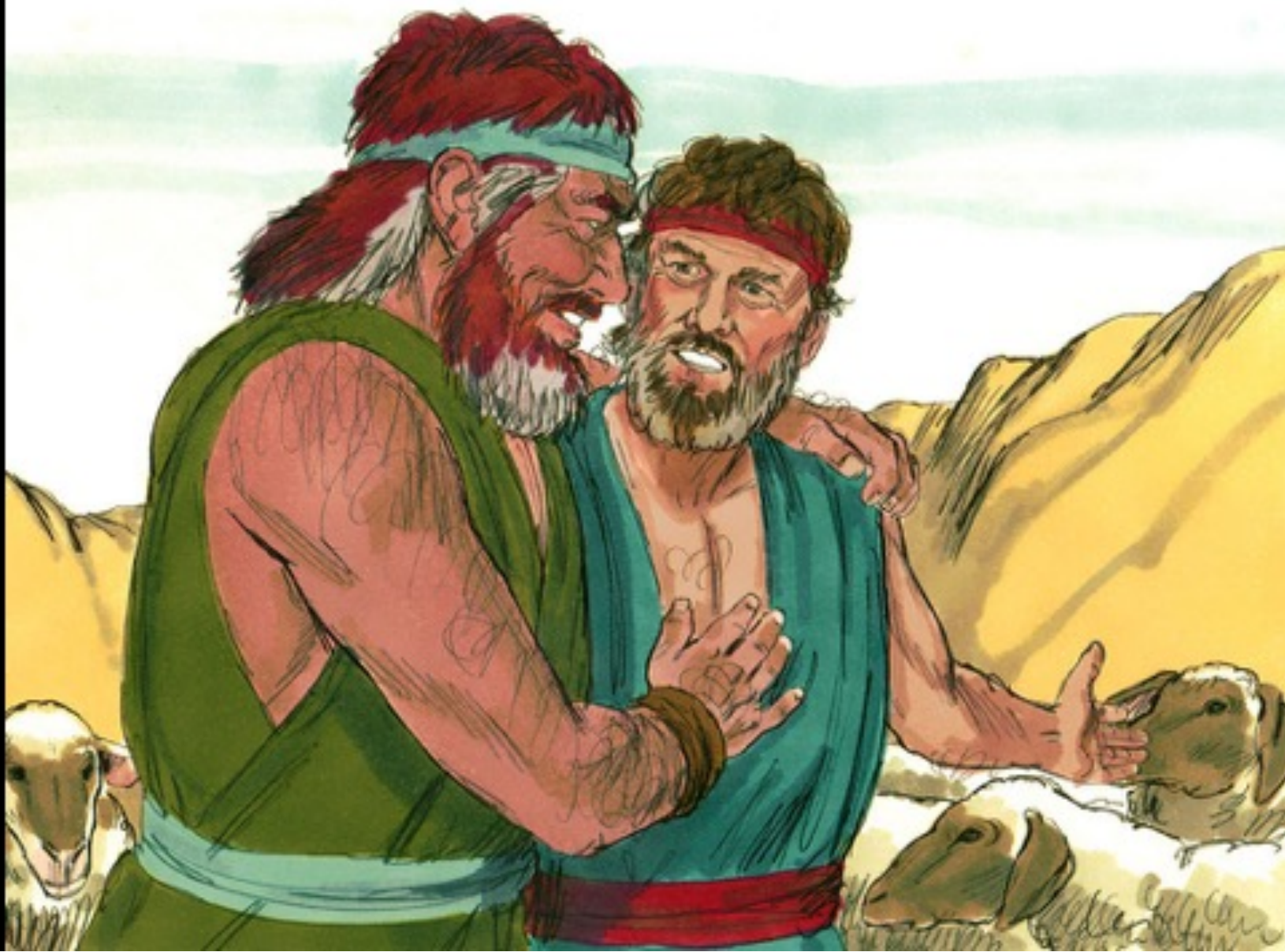

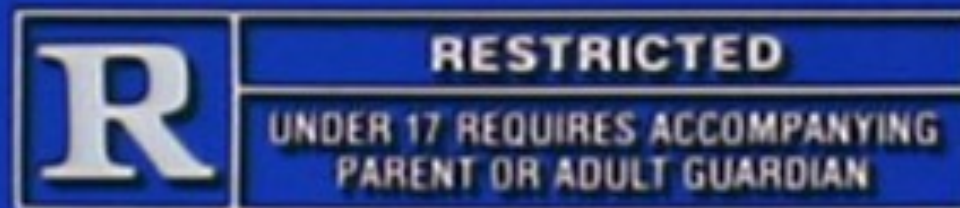

The Trail

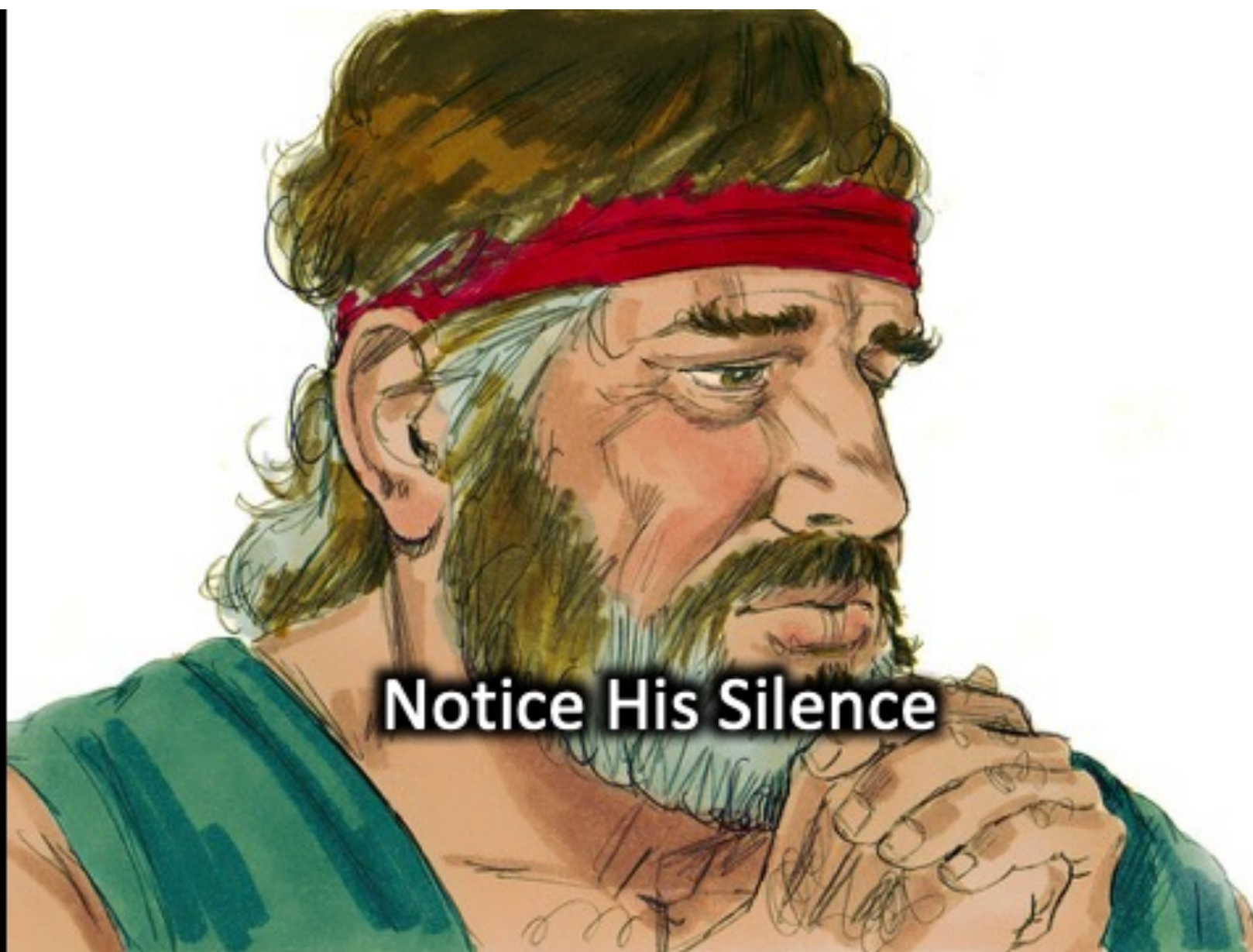


... have pit organs
