In the past months of 2021...

### 1) What have you learned about your ministry?

COVID-19 took away mass church gatherings. More than ever, we must appreciate the wisdom and timelessness of Jesus' ministry model - A Few Good Men. The key strategy of worldwide evangelism and ministry is not about drawing huge crowds into stadiums. It is in life-on-life discipleship, the way Jesus poured His life into 12 ordinary men. His strategy was so effective that after Jesus had been with them, trained them and then left them, they turned the world upside down with their gospel



ministry! Let's learn to give our lives to a few good men (or women) in a quiet, humble and faithful way like Jesus did. That's how we can lead generations into a life-changing relationship with Jesus Christ.

### 2) What have you learned about God?

God is a God of wrath but also mercy. I see that He is a God of wrath - judging this world of sin with the many calamities, diseases, and sufferings of this life.

But at the same time, He is a God of mercy - these judgments are given so that we may perhaps be reminded of His wrath and our sin, repent, and be saved! After all, He gave Jesus His son to bear the sins of those who will repent and believe.
