Our strategy for 2021/2022 is to transform our ministries from on-site Ministries to Internet-enabled Ministries to reach a far wider global mission field (especially in restricted access communities).

To do this successfully, we have to continually re-train our workers to think digitally, think bigger, develop unique attractive internet programs/platforms and to build stable internet communication centers in strategic locations.

God willing, we are planning to bring the Gospel to MILLIONS, mentor THOUSANDS & disciple HUNDREDS of pastors/missionaries/leaders in 2023/2024.

Please pray with us that we will be a useful member of our Lord's team to proclaim this Gospel of the Kingdom to all the world before the end comes (Matthew 24:14).

1. REFUGEE MINISTRY

Our missionary to Syrian refugees in Lebanon is now serving as GLCC's International Refugee Coordinator. She is assisted by our Arab (Yemeni) Coordinator for Arab-speaking refugees.

Presently, our 60 volunteers teach about 800 refugees from 7 countries (Afghanistan, Pakistan, Myanmar, Syria, Kurdistan, South Sudan, Yemen).

We have also trained 40 refugee leaders from Myanmar to teach the centers and their community in Malaysia.

2. OUR RETURNED MISSIONARIES FROM INDONESIA to PHILIPPINES

(a) produce a weekly Sunday School program which has been viewed on YouTube 7 million times.

(b) started an online educational school program (that is accredited by the Philippines Department of Education) that aims to reach 10 million students.



3. INDONESIA

(a) Gospel Light for Indonesia (GLFI) conducts 12 different weekly Zoom sessions for different groups with a total weekly average attendance of 1,340 attendees.

(b) Pastors' International Club (PIC)

- approximately 500 Indonesian pastors use Pastor Paul's weekly sermon outlines to preach to their churches each Sunday
- trains 120 pastors/seminarians in Evangelism
- teaches English to 600 pastors/seminarians

4. PHILIPPINES

(a) Police Ministry - our 22 Zoom Coordinators, 28 Mentors together with 767 volunteers from other churches teach Bible to 3,734 policemen weekly.

(b) Our 9 Gospel Light Baptist Churches and 14 children's centers continue to function.

(c) Online Missionaries - our 46 Filipino volunteers teach 70 people in 11 countries (mostly restricted access nations).

(d) Student Movement for Christ International (SMCI) has 21 full-time campus workers/pastors reaching 50 campuses (mostly online) and pastoring the 6 Growpoint churches that were planted through SMCI's campus ministries.



5. CHINA

(a) Online training - Life on Life Missional Discipleship training to 85 leaders from 15 churches.

(b) Online teaching of Chinese to over 200 students from 20 countries.

(c) Online workshops for family life ministries including building strong marriages and parenting.

6. CENTRAL ASIA

(a) Kyrgyzstan - Home for Abused Women and discipling of abused/abandoned wives.

(b) Very Restricted Nation - 2 of our missionaries continue serving under difficult conditions.

7. CAMBODIA

Our outreach/discipleship work now comes under the umbrella of two newly incorporated NGOs, namely Praise Organization in Sihanoukville region and Foundation Education Organization in Koh Kong Province. With this corporatization exercise now completed, there should be more opportunities to reach many more people with the gospel, both online and physically, now.

8. ASIA PACIFIC INSTITUTE OF INTERNATIONAL STUDIES (APIIS), SINGAPORE

APIIS (in partnership with Third Millennial Ministries) provides free 2-year online Master of Ministry (MMin) program to 200 pastors/church workers from 18 countries.


