Sister Hannah Chee will be appointed as the Shepherd (Head) of Children's Ministry effective from January 2022. We caught up with her to ask some questions about her passion for serving the children in Gospel Light.

How has God prepared you to be a Shepherd for the **Children's Ministry?**

Looking back, what I thought I was unconsciously going through was actually God leading, moulding and guiding me into this ministry. I started volunteering in church at 15 and have spent more than half my life in Children's Ministry, but there's still so much to learn! All glory to God for His leading me thus far.

The turning point was discovering God's heart for missions as I read His Word and served others, especially during overseas missions. That led me to see that Children's Ministry as an important aspect of local missions, and the church's outreach to disciple the next generation.

I thank God for mentors – Pastor Jason, Simon, Aunty Suh Jiuan, Pastor Kay Hong, and Aunty May - who have poured into my life these past three years and continue to do so. Apart from practical ministry and leadership advice, they encourage me to drink in the gospel and live out the gospel in order to 'give out the gospel' in this ministry. I am also thankful for Pastor Paul who taught me an important lesson on leadership - to invest in building connections with the volunteers and hopefully in time, with the children's parents.

What are the biggest takeaways while serving in **Children's Ministry?**

The relationships with children, volunteers and even parents. Especially during Covid-19, the weekly meeting reminds us that we have one another as a church and we can point each other to Christ.

An encouraging memory was when one child was initially hesitant in reciting the weekly memory verses and had trouble with it earlier this year. He became more confident through our memory verse fill-in-the-blank routine. Now he comes prepared and excited to recite it without any help!

I was also encouraged to know that there were many children who wanted a Bible so that they could read it for themselves. They're excited to learn how to flip to the book and chapter and find the verse.

What are you most excited about for Children's Ministry in the years to come?

It is my hope and prayer to see the fruit of saving faith in the children's lives. I am also hopeful and excited to see the church coming together - parents, seniors, youths generations investing the Gospel in the next generation, doing the reverse of Judges 2:10. This was the verse that convicted me to get involved in teaching God's Word to the young.

I am also excited and hopeful for the children to be also involved in reaching others – their friends and families for Christ.

• EXPOSITORY BIBLE STUDY – BOOK OF MARK


