

There is a proliferation of knowledge today, and we have a range of options and experiences at our fingertips due to technology. But this has affected our ability to discern between truth and lies. It has also weakened our Christian foundation and beliefs on many fronts. Christians have found it difficult to choose between secular and Biblical counselling.

Thus, BCM was started four years ago, to help people navigate life's complexities and challenges using God's counsel in His Word.

In a highly-educated society and "knowledge-proliferate" generation, many find it difficult to accept that most of our problems are sin-related, and that the antidote is in Scripture.

The fabric of creation can be encapsulated in these verses; one is the will of God and the other, a choice of man:

- 1. Man and woman are created in the image of God Gen 1:27-28
- 2. Sin destroyed the innocence of mankind and brought consequences Gen 3:6,15-19

Mankind was created pure. But we gravitate towards impurities because of our "adopted" sinful nature. Sin continues to distort our beliefs, thoughts and values. From the Genesis narrative we understand why Biblical counselling should be different.

### The Four Foundational Principles of Biblical Counselling

- 1. Principle: The Bible is the authoritative source of truth. Counselling theories will be evaluated against this. Truths and lies co-exist and distinguishing them can be difficult, resulting in harmful choices. We point people to God's truth, to help them discern and make wise decisions.
- 2. Person: Ministry to the person is more important than being solution-focused. Input of Biblical truths (Psa 119:9) provides the foundation to manage future challenges. We minister in love, that our clients may sense God's love for them and see their own worth in the light of His Word.
- 3. Problem: If we attempt to resolve just the problems, it may end with us initiating compromises or adaptations that merely provide symptom-relief. Instead, dealing with sin (root cause) presents a lasting solution to many challenges that our clients face.
- 4. Prayers: We pray for wisdom, strength and guidance (Phi 4:6). We learn from Christ, who would make time, even in weariness, to communicate with His Father.

We have counselled people with marital and parenting issues, depression, anxiety, suicidal tendencies, relational and workplace problems, personality disorder, LGBTQ issues, as well as addictions. But in all of these, it is not counselling per se, but the opportunity to speak into each other's lives (Heb 10:24-25).

Opportunities exist on both sides of the door.


