1. Biblical friendships provide Community

Times of isolation can negatively affect us, much like Elijah felt alone in a depressing world. The Bible teaches that we were created to have community. God gave Christians in the church one another, describing us using analogies such as a body, a building, or a family.

Biblical friends have provided me with a place of belonging because of our common bond in Christ: as people who love God and love one another (1 John 3:23). They can relate in a deeper way compared to non-Christian friends, allowing space for spiritual conversations. Close friends in church have also greatly encouraged me when ministry work was tough, as they strived beside me for the faith of the gospel (Phil 1:27). The community we can enjoy through Christ is a wonderful form of God's grace.

2. Biblical friendships provide Correction

Iron sharpens iron, and one man sharpens another (Pro 27:17). We can all agree that as individuals with limited perspective, we often have shortcomings we never realised. Biblical friends have been crucial in providing much-needed feedback when I've made unwise decisions or thoughtless comments. Although it's good to reflect on criticism, no matter the source, it is more pleasant to receive faithful feedback from a friend because I know they come from a heart of honesty and concern. Having such friends creates a healthier environment for spiritual growth, as we build each other up and restore one another in a spirit of gentleness (Gal 6:1).

3. Biblical friendships provide Care

Not long ago, I was served a Quarantine Order. While thankfully I did not contract COVID-19, the time of isolation was mentally taxing. Biblical friends lifted me up and kept my sanity in check when I was feeling down (Ecc 4:9-10). There have been many other times when Biblical friends came alongside in my time of need and provided support. Even if they could not physically help, it was reassuring knowing that others were lifting me up in prayer. A friend loves at all times, and a brother is born for adversity (Pro 17:17). We face many trials, but we can count on Biblical friends to share our burdens.

I hope this season pushes us to invest even more in building strong Biblical friendships. At the same time, let us remember that Jesus is the friend that sticks closer than a brother, and our connection with Him is something no social distancing measure can affect.




