

### **COMMON PARENTING MISTAKES (PART 1)**

I must admit that when the church asked me to write an article on common parenting mistakes, I was apprehensive because I felt so unqualified. I have made so many parenting mistakes in the last 19 years. But after prayer, I decided to write from my experience and observations. My hope is that others can learn from my mistakes and observations. In this article, I will discuss three common parenting mistakes.

### Mistake No. 1 – Adopting an Authoritarian Style

Authoritarian parents maintain a high level of control over their children. They set very strict rules and are likely to punish their children if the rules are broken. Such parents adopt a top-down approach, with little or no reasoning with their children. In fact, children in such homes have little or no say. They are expected to do as they are told. Authoritarian parents seldom praise their children. But any slight infringement by their children will bring about a scolding or punishment. This parenting style is typical of many Asian families, especially the older generation. Children in such families may suffer from low self-esteem, and rebel against authority figures when older.

Research has shown that children of highly authoritarian parents are likely to become authoritarian parents themselves. In fact, I grew up in such a home. And when I became a parent, I too sought to impose a high level of control over my children. I set strict rules, and would often scold or punish them if these rules were broken. But over the years, I have learned that authoritarian parenting is detrimental to the parent-child relationship. And I have also learned that rules without a relationship will likely lead to rebellion. Gradually, I began to change my parenting style, from authoritarian to authoritative (more on this in the second part of my article next week). I found that my relationships with my children began to improve.

### Mistake No. 2 – Adopting a Permissive Style

Permissive parents are attentive and warm towards their children, but do not set many rules. Such parents are low on authority and often have trouble saying "no". In fact, permissive parents often have trouble getting their children to obey them and speak respectfully. Some may even resort to bribing their children with gifts in exchange for good behaviour. Research has shown that children of permissive parents may show higher levels of creativity but are likely to feel entitled, that is, they are more interested in taking rather than giving in their own relationships. In some cases, permissive parenting can lead to poor self-control and behavioural issues in children.

• Vaccinated individuals refer to those who have:

o Been fully vaccinated, i.e. has received the appropriate regimen of World Health Organisation Emergency Use Listing (WHO EUL) vaccines including their respective duration post-vaccination for the vaccine to be fully effective, and had their vaccination records ingested in MOH's national IT systems; or o Recovered from COVID-19 within the last 180 days

• From 14 February 2022 onwards, persons aged 18 years and above who have completed the primary vaccination series of COVID-19 vaccines and are eligible for booster vaccination will be considered as fully vaccinated for 270 days after the last dose in their primary vaccination series. The same will apply to persons aged 12-17 years old from 14 March 2022. Persons who have recovered from COVID-19 and have completed their primary series vaccination do not require an additional booster dose at this point in time.

• Only vaccination records that are available via HealthHub app or TraceTogether app/token are accepted.

• We seek your understanding that worshippers who do not fulfil the above vaccination criteria will be turned away on-site.

- There will be no change to our Sunday morning prayer meeting at 8:15am via Zoom.
- English Meet the Pastor Session will be at 10:20am.
