

"Father, forgive them, for they know not what they do." (Luke 23:34 ESV)

These were some of the last words of our Lord Jesus Christ, who was crucified on the cross.

There He was, hanging and bleeding from wounds inflicted by the Romans who hated him, and scorned by the ones whom He still loved. In the final moments of Jesus' life on earth, He chose to intercede for others; those who opposed Him. While suffering in what must have been excruciating pain, He chose forgiveness over taking revenge.

Jesus chose to extend grace and mercy to those responsible for pinning Him on the cross – the Romans, the Jewish leaders, and those who mocked and scoffed at Him. He also meant to forgive everyone He was dying for, which includes you and I. This is radical forgiveness - total unreserved forgiveness for the undeserved.

Christ also died for the two thieves who were crucified alongside Him. While one chose to remain unrepentant, the other put aside his pride and recognised Jesus to be a guiltless sacrifice, and His deity.

And he said, "Jesus, remember me when you come into your kingdom." (Luke 23:42 ESV)

And he said to him, "Truly, I say to you, today you will be with me in paradise." (Luke 23:43 ESV)

As Easter approaches, let us remember Jesus' ultimate sacrifice for us on the cross as we celebrate the empty tomb. For our King has risen, and He is alive. We have the privilege and access to join Him in heaven one day because He bore our sins and took our punishment.

It is easy to live in the forgiveness that Jesus died for. Yet, it can sometimes be difficult to 'pass it on' to others.

When was the last time you felt betrayed, humiliated, or offended? Especially in the virtual space?

What was your initial response?

We live in a time when social media is ubiquitous, and people get offended easily by 'keyboard warriors' or comments that are lost in translation. Social movements like 'cancel culture' also lead to more bashing and bullying. How do we navigate such tricky spaces as Christians? By following the example of Jesus who modelled it from the start, until His last breath.

Radical forgiveness is not something we can do naturally or within our own will. We love and forgive because He first loved and forgave us.

So when we find ourselves offended by others even after Easter, let us remember what Jesus chose to say and do from the cross. May we follow in His example as we aim towards sincere progression as true disciples.



WORSHIP SERVICE

Following the latest measures by MCCY (26 Mar 2022), some of the key changes we will be implementing with effect from 29 March 2022 are:

- 1. No need for online registration to attend worship services.
- 2. Free seating, no zoning required.
- 3. Capacity limits for the various congregations are revised and listed in the table below.
- 4. Congregational singing is permitted with masks on.
- 5. Post service fellowship is permitted but limited to group sizes of 10, with 1m distancing between groups.
- 6. Gospeliters may bring their own food for consumption on-site subject to the following:
 - a. Food must be in individually packed portions, no sharing of food;
 - b. Group size is limited to 10 pax, with 1m distancing between groups;
 - c. No intermingling of groups whilst consuming food;
 - d. Food must be consumed whilst stationary, no walking about; and
 - e. Write in to shine@gospellight.sg to book venue and indicate that your group will be consuming food.

- Vaccinated individuals refer to those who have:
 - o Been fully vaccinated, i.e. has received the appropriate regimen of World Health Organisation Emergency Use Listing (WHO EUL) vaccines including their respective duration post-vaccination for the vaccine to be fully effective, and had their vaccination records ingested in MOH's national IT systems; or
 - o Recovered from COVID-19 within the last 180 days
- From 14 February 2022 onwards, persons aged 18 years and above who have completed the primary vaccination series of COVID-19 vaccines and are eligible for booster vaccination will be considered as fully vaccinated for 270 days after the last dose in their primary vaccination series. The same will apply to persons aged 12-17 years old from 14 March 2022. Persons who have recovered from COVID-19 and have completed their primary series vaccination do not require an additional booster dose at this point in time.
- Only vaccination records that are available via HealthHub app or TraceTogether app/token are accepted.
- We seek your understanding that worshippers who do not fulfil the above vaccination criteria will be turned away onsite
