

Armed conflicts are common. Lately, the war in Ukraine has had more media attention than others, perhaps because it happened in the West. As expected, Christians have varied reactions. But, the question we should ask is "How should we respond?"

The finger-pointing in condemning despotic leaders comes almost naturally, doesn't it? But, as Christians we should respond biblically. First, let's not be surprised, yet be good-tempered. Jesus warned us that 'wars and rumors of war' would escalate in these last days. We should empathize with the innocent victims. Otherwise, we won't bother to pray and find ways to help them.

Let's respect geopolitical expert analysts' perspectives about the 'whys' of conflicts, according to their ideologies and worldviews. However, the biblical view differs. Simplistic as it sounds, sin is the origin of conflict. Isn't an unregenerate man, at his best, self-seeking? As James said, "For where jealousy and selfish ambition exist, there will be disorder and every vile practice." ² Cain murdered his brother Abel for this reason. Furthermore, James asked, "What causes quarrels and what causes fights among you? Is it not this, that your passions are at war within you? You desire and do not have, so you murder. You covet and cannot obtain, so you fight and quarrel." ³

Sadly, as we see the devastations of war, the question 'Why is it happening?' is irrepressible. The grotesque images are hard to bear. Nevertheless, we take solace that God is always 'too good to be unkind and too wise

to commit mistakes.' God didn't move an inch from His throne as His Son was brutally nailed at the cross. He allowed this for His own sovereign glory. As the psalmist declares, "Surely the wrath of man shall praise you." 4

Lastly, we should not overlook the story in Luke 13. Some asked Jesus whether the Galileans whose blood Pilate had mingled with their sacrifices were worse sinners than others. And, whether the eighteen people killed when the Siloam tower fell were worse offenders than others. Jesus did not answer directly. Instead, He pointed them to their greatest need, saying, "No, I tell you; but unless you repent, you will all likewise perish." ⁵ In other words, in tragedies, whether instigated by man or nature, it's not our priority to seek who to blame. But, it is to examine our hearts and ask, "Have I repented of my sins and made my heart right with God?" I pray and hope we all do.

- Vaccinated individuals refer to those who have:
 - o Been fully vaccinated, i.e. has received the appropriate regimen of World Health Organisation Emergency Use Listing (WHO EUL) vaccines including their respective duration post-vaccination for the vaccine to be fully effective, and had their vaccination records ingested in MOH's national IT systems; or
 - o Recovered from COVID-19 within the last 180 days
- From 14 February 2022 onwards, persons aged 18 years and above who have completed the primary vaccination series of COVID-19 vaccines and are eligible for booster vaccination will be considered as fully vaccinated for 270 days after the last dose in their primary vaccination series. The same will apply to persons aged 12-17 years old from 14 March 2022. Persons who have recovered from COVID-19 and have completed their primary series vaccination do not require an additional booster dose at this point in time.
- Only vaccination records that are available via HealthHub app or TraceTogether app/token are accepted.
- We seek your understanding that worshippers who do not fulfil the above vaccination criteria will be turned away onsite.
