

# SOME QUESTIONS ABOUT THE BULLETPROOF MARRIAGE WORKSHOP

# "Why attend Bulletproof marriage workshop? You think my spouse will shoot me, is it?"

As one of the Bulletproof Marriage mentors, this question has always struck me as missing the target. The workshop's aim is to build resilience in couples, to withstand spiritual assaults on their marriages.

There is no denying that we live in a modern and worldly society, one that has brought certain difficulties and temptations into marriage, and which Christians are not immune to. In the secular world, materialism is encouraged, with many pleasures, lawful or illicit, within reach. We have invariably heard of families which have been broken up by addictions, infidelity, abuse, financial issues, as well as differences in opinion or personalities. It seems like our instant gratification culture is telling us "Life is short. Do what makes you happy. If you're not happy, just change".

# "So extreme, that will never happen to us"

This might be your reaction, but did you know that according to the Department of Statistics, Singapore's divorce rate has increased more than seven-fold in the last thirty years? By year-end, there will be roughly 7,000 fewer married couples (some with children).

It is worthwhile to ask: are you and your spouse equipping yourselves to deal with the forces working against your marriage? If not, I would like to invite you to join the Bulletproof Marriage Workshop series in July.

The workshops began two years ago, shortly after the pandemic, to connect with, equip and strengthen couples in their marriages. The program has grown steadily, spread by word of mouth, and even attracted participants from

outside the church, as well as overseas. To date, more than 120 couples have graduated, with a better understanding of what a Christ-centered marriage is. Some have salvaged relationships and stepped back from the precipice of separation. Some have newfound joy. All agreed it was a positive experience.

The program consists of four evening sessions, covering God's intention for marriage, with an assigned marriage mentor couple journeying with you for some time. You can call on them should you ever encounter an issue in the future.

#### "Who should attend Bulletproof?"

Whether newly married or celebrating your diamond anniversary, whether trying to overcome marriage obstacles or enduring personal challenges, you are welcome to attend. Sessions are confidential, and there is no compulsion to share details. Consider this a spiritual tune-up and a way to strengthen your marriage.

- Vaccinated individuals refer to those who have:
  - o Been fully vaccinated, i.e. has received the appropriate regimen of World Health Organisation Emergency Use Listing (WHO EUL) vaccines including their respective duration post-vaccination for the vaccine to be fully effective, and had their vaccination records ingested in MOH's national IT systems; or
- o Recovered from COVID-19 within the last 180 days
- From 14 February 2022 onwards, persons aged 18 years and above who have completed the primary vaccination series of COVID-19 vaccines and are eligible for booster vaccination will be considered as fully vaccinated for 270 days after the last dose in their primary vaccination series. The same will apply to persons aged 12-17 years old from 14 March 2022. Persons who have recovered from COVID-19 and have completed their primary series vaccination do not require an additional booster dose at this point in time.
- Only vaccination records that are available via HealthHub app or TraceTogether app/token are accepted.
- We seek your understanding that worshippers who do not fulfil the above vaccination criteria will be turned away on-site.
