

A GLCC MISSIONARY TO ISRAEL

My father is a pastor in a rural area in the Philippines and my mother is a teacher in a Bible school. Growing up, I watched my parents overcoming life's challenges as they served the Lord. Life was not easy but the Lord was with us every step of the way.

In 2015, I trained in Camp Goducate Philippines to become a community worker, prepared to serve God wherever He called. From 2016 to 2020, I served in Indonesia and taught pastors, church workers and children.

Going to Israel to serve the Jews never crossed my mind. But everything changed in November 2018, when I became curious about the Jewish people. I believe it was the Lord who stirred that up. I did research online. I sensed the amazing sincerity, depth and devotion to God among the Messianic Jews (that is, Jews who believe that Jesus is their Savior).

My prayers gradually shifted from Indonesia's Batak tribe to the Jewish people in Israel. I would usually shed tears as I prayed for the Batak people, but I noticed that I was no longer crying for them. Instead, I was crying for the Jewish people. This continued for several weeks. I sensed that God was sending me a message He wanted me to pay close attention to. It took awhile to muster the courage to ask God about His will.

November 10, 2019 was my turning point. I could not take it anymore. The burden God placed in my heart would not go away. While alone at home, I stepped outside and sat beside a table facing Lake Toba and looked at the heavens. I asked God, "Are You calling me to serve the Jews?" Then I entered the house, grabbed my Bible and prayed to the Lord to speak through His

word. As I opened my eyes, He led me to several verses. The first one was Ezekiel 2:3: "And he said to me, 'Son of man, I send you to the people of Israel, to nations of rebels, who have rebelled against me. They and their fathers have transgressed against me to this very day'. He also led me to Isaiah 62.

In 2020, I said my goodbyes in Indonesia and went home to the Philippines. From that year, God led me to several people and organizations, and opened doors. I am now processing my volunteer visa to Israel. I will be serving the returning Jews in Aliyah Return Center in Galilee.

I believe that we are living in the days when God is fulfilling His promise to bring His people home and restore them to Him. And He would like the Gentile nations to be part of this story. Yes, He is coming back soon!

- Vaccinated individuals refer to those who have:
 - o Been fully vaccinated, i.e. has received the appropriate regimen of World Health Organisation Emergency Use Listing (WHO EUL) vaccines including their respective duration post-vaccination for the vaccine to be fully effective, and had their vaccination records ingested in MOH's national IT systems; or
 - o Recovered from COVID-19 within the last 180 days
- From 14 February 2022 onwards, persons aged 18 years and above who have completed the primary vaccination series of COVID-19 vaccines and are eligible for booster vaccination will be considered as fully vaccinated for 270 days after the last dose in their primary vaccination series. The same will apply to persons aged 12-17 years old from 14 March 2022. Persons who have recovered from COVID-19 and have completed their primary series vaccination do not require an additional booster dose at this point in time.
- Only vaccination records that are available via HealthHub app or TraceTogether app/token are accepted.
- We seek your understanding that worshippers who do not fulfil the above vaccination criteria will be turned away on-site.
