

SHOULD A CHRISTIAN BE PATRIOTIC?

National Day is in two days. Across the land, we see red and white flags and decorations going up. We hear national songs on the airwaves, and in shopping centres and supermarkets. I saw many emphatic social media posts on the National Day Parade Preview over the last weekend of July. When we see our national athletes do well at the Olympics, World Championships or Southeast Asian Games, most of us can't help but feel a surge of pride and joy. We celebrate in their successes, as a country. In Singapore, men go for National Service. Quite a number of us at Gospel Light Christian Church have served as regulars in the Singapore Armed Forces, or are still serving. Many of us, whether in public service or the private sector, try to fly the Singapore flag high in our field of study, or in our place of regional/international work. I feel that there is a rightful place for Christians to be thankful for the country in which God has placed us, and to work for the country's good.

this world is not our eternal home, and that we "seek a heavenly country" (Hebrews 11:10,16); we are to, at the same time, ardently seek the peace and well-being of the earthly country we are placed in.

Hang on. Some might ask how what I've just written compares against passages of Scripture like "my Kingdom is not of this world" (John 18:36), "our citizenship is in heaven" (Phil 3:20), and "love not the world" (1 John 2:15).

I find Scripture to be very balanced in this regard. Consider Jeremiah 29:4-7:

"Thus saith the LORD of hosts, the God of Israel, unto all that are carried away captives, whom I have caused to be carried away from Jerusalem unto Babylon; Build ye houses, and dwell in them; and plant gardens, and eat the fruit of them; Take ye wives, and beget sons and daughters; and take wives for your sons, and give your daughters to husbands, that they may bear sons and daughters; that ye may be increased there, and not diminished. And **seek the peace of the city** whither I have caused you to be carried away captives, and **pray unto the LORD** for it: for in the peace thereof shall ye have peace."

What Scripture is saying is that while we need to be crystal clear that this world is not our eternal home, and that we "seek a heavenly country" (Hebrews 11:10,16); we are to, at the same time, ardently seek the peace and well-being of the earthly country we are placed in. And this is exactly what many past generations of Christians did.

Singapore is a very prosperous country. We need to take care that patriotism does not give way to pride or prejudice. Remember that Galatians 3:28 says "there is neither Jew nor Greek...for ye are all one in Christ", and Revelations 21:24 paints a scene in Heaven at the end of time where "the nations of them that are saved shall walk in it".

So yes, for this National Day, let's don our red and white, and be proud to be Singaporeans. And pray that God will continue to bless Singapore and guide our leaders (1 Tim 2:1-2); and for Christians in Singapore to be salt and light (Matthew 5:13-16); to do justly, walk humbly and to love mercy (Micah 4:6); and to be a blessing to those around us.



- Vaccinated individuals refer to those who have:
- o Been fully vaccinated, i.e. has received the appropriate regimen of World Health Organisation Emergency Use Listing (WHO EUL) vaccines including their respective duration post-vaccination for the vaccine to be fully effective, and had their vaccination records ingested in MOH's national IT systems; or
- o Recovered from COVID-19 within the last 180 days
- From 14 February 2022 onwards, persons aged 18 years and above who have completed the primary vaccination series of COVID-19 vaccines and are eligible for booster vaccination will be considered as fully vaccinated for 270 days after the last dose in their primary vaccination series. The same will apply to persons aged 12-17 years old from 14 March 2022. Persons who have recovered from COVID-19 and have completed their primary series vaccination do not require an additional booster dose at this point in time.
- Only vaccination records that are available via HealthHub app or TraceTogether app/token are accepted.
- We seek your understanding that worshippers who do not fulfil the above vaccination criteria will be turned away on-site.
