

3 MYTHS ABOUT CARE GROUPS

Care Groups (CGs) exist so that there are small communities that allow for deeper fellowship. However, when someone joins a CG for the first time, expectations can vary. Three common myths are described below.

Myth 1 – CGs exists for others to care for me and meet my needs.

As its name suggests, CGs are small communities set up specifically for us to experience care and concern. While that is true, CGs do not exist only for others to meet your needs, but also for you to love God by loving His body, the church. CGs allow you to love one another with the love of Christ. This is completely different from solely expecting others to meet your needs. When CG members follow the call of Jesus to love one another with His love, they will be able to meet one another's needs (c.f. John 15:12).

Myth 2 – CGs, unlike the world, will not have messy relationships.

There are sometimes unspoken expectations that CGs are comprised of members who are godly and loving, unlike people in the world. However, someone who joins a CG may meet people who say unkind words, or even complain overbearingly. The fact remains that CGs are comprised of sinners, and relationships will not be easy. However, God desires close fellowship among his people (c.f. Heb 10: 24-25) and for us to live out the gospel through experiencing His grace, so that we can be sanctified. In the New Testament, there are countless "one anothers" in which God commands the church to "forgive one another", "love one another", "admonish one another", "serve one another", "honour one another" and "bear with one another". This is just to name a few. It is in a CG where God's grace enables us to overcome relational messiness and help us to be more Christlike.

Myth 3 – CGs should avoid social or outreach activities and focus only on Bible study.

Don't misunderstand. Bible study is needed in CGs and should not be neglected. Bible study allows us to know God's word. However, the deeper reality is in applying these truths to know God, to relate how the gospel transforms lives in areas such as marriage and work, to live out the gospel for victory over sins, as well as to nurture a growing desire to love and serve one another. Therefore, CGs cannot be only about Bible study. It must also be a place to know one another, and to serve unchurched communities by witnessing to unbelievers about the power of the gospel in changing lives.






• CHIT CHAT! (NEWCOMERS EVENT)

Invite your friends or come explore the evidence for God in a 4 part series. As we help you investigate the claims of Christianity and ask important questions about the Christian faith.


