

## **GOING FOR GOD IN 2023**

As we begin a new year, it is timely to reflect on how we can be more faithful and fruitful in our faith journeys.

Several people have started to travel this year. You would have noticed how the dutiful pilots are always in the planes early, verifying the cockpit gauges and flight systems to ensure that the plane is *worthy* for the flight ahead. Likewise, when my family was travelling often to Malaysia, the first important task for me was to send my car early to the workshop. The car technicians would be informed about the long road trip, and they would inspect the car to deem it road*worthy*. Of course, the consequences if something goes wrong in these situations are high. Therefore, early preparation is important for pilots and anyone going on a long road trip.

To be ready for 2023 and 'Going for God', you might start by seeking to weigh what is 'worthy' and how to be 'worthy'. We could learn from Paul as he wrote to the Philippians:

"Only let your manner of life be worthy of the gospel of Christ." (Phil 1:27a)

Paul used 'only' to emphasize that if there is ONLY one thing the Philippians should place first, it is that their lived-out lives be truly worthy of the Gospel. Nothing should be more important than this, as Paul exalted the Philippians. Remember, the Philippians wanted to encourage Paul, as he was imprisoned and living almost every day in mortal danger. Instead, Paul responded by pointing the Philippians to a greater mission -- to do just ONE thing. That was to press on in their walk against the weight of the price of Christ's redemption.

Dear brethren, make 2023 an impactful year for Christ, by examining our manner of life (now and ahead) and carefully preparing it for the purpose of the Gospel, just like a responsible pilot prepares the plane for its flight. Are there areas we need to surrender to God? Have we been <u>distracted</u> by the lures of the world, <u>dulled</u> by our own fleshly pursuits, or <u>derailed</u> by unwise decisions? Have we been busy with our ministries, and yet the outcome is only emptiness? Ministries that cost nothing accomplish nothing. Is there Gospel-centricity in your ministries or has this been moved to the periphery?

For 2023, let us be going for God by first being singleminded (only), examining our lived-out lives (manner) and weighing this against the goal (the gospel) of our faith. Paul reminded us that we are pilgrims here and citizens of heaven. The phrase 'manner of life' signifies living like citizens of Christ's kingdom. We are reminded to be the aroma of Christ and bring the fragrance of life to those around us.
