

# **KEEPING THE FAITH IN UNIVERSITY AND ARMY**

In Luke 8, Jesus tells the parable of the sower, who sows seeds which fall on different types of ground. The seeds' growth depends on the kind of soil they fall on, and some seeds grow better than others. Jesus says that the seeds represent the word of God. For some people, the seeds cannot fully grow because they do not take root, and testing of their faith reveals an improper foundation. For others, they are choked by the cares and riches and pleasures of life, and their fruit does not mature.

This parable describes clearly two big struggles that Varsity members face. First, a shaky foundation. Nothing reveals a shaky foundation like suffering. Nothing reveals a lack of a personal relationship with God more than suffering. Suddenly, God's character comes into question. Many ask questions. "Is God really loving? Is my faith real? How can God allow this to happen to me? How can we say that God is good if there is suffering in the world?" Second, Varsity members face a fierce battle to keep up with the world's expectations. Social media bombards them with the lie that a life of luxury, holidays, extravagant food, and a goodpaying job can give true satisfaction and joy. Social media sells them the lie that they can find true satisfaction in chasing the pleasures of life. The Singapore dream is what they ultimately chase instead of God. They chase treasures on earth instead of treasures from above.

There's often not much I can do in these circumstances. I often tell others that there are three things I do, and intend to keep doing, in 2023. I preach my heart out, pray my heart out and then cry my heart out. In preaching God's word faithfully, I bring them to God's powerful word that can give life and effect change. It's really not about the attractiveness of the activities, but the powerful word of God that can effect change in their lives. Then, I pray my heart out, knowing that it is God who works in their hearts. It's a supernatural battle that they are engaged in. Only God can show Himself as more appealing than anything the world offers. Lastly, I cry tears of joy when their lives change, and I give thanks that I get a front-row seat to God's supernatural work. When they choose to walk away from the faith or make poor decisions, I cry tears of sorrow and then repeat the cycle again.

This year, would you pray with me for the Varsity ministry, that they would see Jesus as the most appealing and satisfying treasure?
