

BECAUSE HE LIVES (REFLECTIONS ON THE RESURRECTION)

For joy awakes as dawning light, when Christ's disciples lift their eyes.

Alive He stands, their Friend and King: Christ, Christ He is risen!

Imagine how the disciples felt when they saw their risen Saviour for the very first time? Days ago, they had seen their Teacher nailed to the cross, heard his last cry of "It is finished!", wrapped him in burial garments, and placed him in the tomb. Now Jesus was standing before them in a glorious, resurrected body. He showed them the wounds on His hands and side. Imagine their growing excitement as they declared, "We have seen the Lord!".

This event altered their lives forever.

- 1. Because He lives, Jesus fulfils the foretelling of His death and resurrection.
 - Jesus foretold he would be killed and raised to life in three days (Mk 8:31-33, 9:30-31). He declared during the temple cleansing, "Destroy this temple, and in three days I will raise it up." (Jn 2:19). In God's infinite wisdom, the sovereign plan of salvation already included the suffering, death, burial and resurrection of our Lord.
- 2. Because He lives, Jesus proves He has conquered sin, death and hell.

Death entered our world as a penalty of sin. Man suffers from both physical death and being

spiritually dead in sin due to Adam's disobedience. But Jesus led a blameless, sinless life, paid for our sins and rose again!

Being fully God, Jesus had the authority to lay down his life and to take it up again (Jn 10:17-18). He is the resurrection and the life (Jn 11:25-26). He is the Bread of Life and the Living Water. With Jesus' resurrection, death has lost its sting! He will return again, ensuring that death is the last enemy to be destroyed (1 Co 15:24-26).

- 3. Because He lives, Jesus gives us a glorious hope.
- The disciples later remembered what Jesus said at the temple and believed His words (Jn 2:22). The apostles who saw the resurrected Christ went about preaching with boldness, and this cost them their lives. What motivated them?

Jesus' triumph over death and His resurrection gives us hope that we will likewise be raised with Him (1 Co 15:22). There will be a day when every tear will be wiped away, and pain and death will be no more (Rev 21:4). This is every Christian's hope. This gives us strength to face trials and tribulations for the sake of His name.

This Easter, let's recap our journey in 1 Co. 15 about the resurrection of Christ. Let us be steadfast, immovable, always abounding in the work of our Lord, who loved us and gave Himself for us.


