

TICK TOCK... (OUR STEWARDSHIP OF TIME)

A child is listening to his teacher. He wonders, "when will this end?". He glances at the wall clock. He had been listening to such talks for five years. If it's not Science, it's Social Studies or English.

In an office block, a manager tries to be attentive to a regional executive's briefing. His thoughts shutter between the briefing slides and his dinner appointment. It is 7:00pm and the briefing is nowhere near the end. His days are filled with briefings, meetings or reports. Sixteen years have slipped by.

Gazing out the window, an elderly couple at home laments about things they should have done differently. Their paths in life changed as they matured. Along with proper spiritual direction and godly counsel, they charted a "meeting of hearts". He turns towards her and says, "I wish I had taken care of you better. I won your heart in the initial years but I, like so many, failed to cherish you over the years. I am glad we are ending well, but we lost 25 good years."

These are not isolated incidents, but remarks by the same man, from his childhood to the day of his retirement. He is referring to a treasure that often goes unnoticed.

We often think of treasure as possessions, achievements, positions, and valuables. Sometimes, we may include loved ones, relationships, keepsakes, and memories. I say "sometimes" because we do not even usually see these as treasures. I too am guilty, and used to have a very shallow understanding of "treasures" and a narrow perception of what I deemed priceless. Take the example of time. God has given it in the same daily proportion to all. No one can bottle it for sale. Time is free, like air, yet it is priceless. I have often taken it for granted. I have realised that many treasures, when lost, misplaced or stolen, can be replaced. But time, once gone, can never be replaced or retrieved. It marches only forward. Understanding this has changed my appreciation and value of time. It is not unlimited or re-usable.

These three guidelines can help us embrace time to its fullest:

1. Treasure it wisely

It is an earthy trust which invested wisely, will produce eternal treasures.

"So teach us to number our days, that we may apply our hearts unto wisdom." Psa 90:12

2. Use it intentionally.

It is a limited resource extended only by giving the first part back to the Lord.

"Honour the Lord... with the firstfruits..." Pro 3:9-10

3. Guard it zealously

It is a daily priceless treasure (from our LORD) which attracts many robbers.

"Redeeming the time, because the days are evil ..." Eph 5:16
