

3 REASONS NOT TO SERVE IN SUNDAY SCHOOL

1. "I've never taught kids before, and I don't know how to handle them."

Not to worry, training will be provided. Reaching children requires patience and a willing heart to care and listen. Facilitation and classroom management skills can always be picked up along the way.

2. "I don't know enough of the Bible."

Actually, none of us do, and we are all constantly learning as we prepare the lessons. It's okay not to have all the answers all the time, and sometimes, we may even learn from the questions they ask.

3. "I don't like kids/ I have enough of kids (at school/home)."

Liking kids would be great, but we must remember that the Gospel isn't only for the likable or the lovable. Perhaps we might want a break from dealing with more children on weekends, but may we be willing to take turns and sacrifice our time to be a blessing to other parents and families.

Three reasons why you should

1. Children need to hear the gospel

Our children may be cute and innocent, but we should not be mistaken that they too are sinners in need of the Gospel. Children can believe in the Gospel, as God's work of salvation is not limited by age or inadequate understanding. Therefore, our aim is to continually point them to the Gospel that they may hear and come to believe (Romans 10:14-15).

2. Children (and families) need to know that the church cares for them

Our children need to know that the church is God's family and experience what being part of God's family is like. They will know this belonging when they see that there is a community invested in them and who can help them grow in their faith. We need to welcome them into God's family, just as Christ did. (Mark 10:13-16)

3. Children need to learn how to read God's Word for themselves and know that God's Word is true and relevant

Today, our kids are over-exposed to a constant influx and availability of instant information. They are hyper-aware of what's going on and it will challenge and influence their worldview. They are either getting more informed by the world, or transformed by the Word. More than ever, they need God's Word, and we can help them grow in this.

And 1 reason why you (hopefully) would

1. It is the great commission

Christ has commanded us, "Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you..." (Matthew 28:19-20) The harvest field of the next generation is in our church. Let us take heed and obey this command to go and teach and disciple the children, that they might grow in faith.

• CHURCH CAMP BRIEFING


All campers are requested to attend the church camp briefing on Sunday 21 May 2023 at 12:30pm in Shine Auditorium directly after the second service.
