The fall of leaders should lead us to appreciate our saviour even more. Our hopes are ultimately not to be placed on fallible man, but on the sinless Son of God.

What does this teach us about the nature of sin (in others and ourselves)?

Though the regenerate are given new hearts that love God, we are still strapped on with sinful flesh that wants to rear its ugly head. Oh how we long for that Day when Jesus returns for us, and takes away this body of sin, and gifts us glorious, incorruptible bodies that will never sin! Till then, we must all remain sober, vigilant and diligent in fighting sin by Word, prayer and gospel community, in dependence on His Spirit.

What do their failings teach us about the need for spiritual accountability and community?

Proverbs 28:13 says: "Whoever conceals his transgressions will not prosper, but he who confesses and forsakes them will obtain mercy." Sin concealed in the dark festers and deepens. Gospel community is a means of grace for us to bring our sins into the light to kill them. We need such safe, grace-filled, gospel-centred spiritual environments for our spiritual well-being. While many people think leaders are "above these things", the reality is that spiritual leaders need spiritual accountability and community too (if not more)! Do you have one?

How can the church support their restoration and return?

Tim Keller said, "The gospel is this: We are more sinful and flawed in ourselves than we ever dared believe, yet at the very same time we are more loved and accepted in Jesus Christ than we ever dared hope." It is the gospel that frees us from condemning guilt and shame. And it is the gospel that enables us to be humble before God and man. We need the gospel so that we can lovingly and graciously pray and reach out to the fallen amongst us. May we be a gospel-centred church that receives sinners and restores the fallen.
