

THE PORNOGRAPHY EPIDEMIC (PART 1)

Pornography is big business. In one study, it is estimated that between US\$10 to US\$14 billion is spent on pornography annually.

What is pornography?

Pornography is a combination of two Greek words: *porne* which means "prostitutes" and *graphein* meaning "to write about." In today's context, *pornography is anything that one uses for personal sexual arousal*. This can range from explicit images and videos to adult novels and explicit anime.

How serious is the issue of pornography addiction in church?

In one recent study in the US, it was found that 90% of children between the ages of 8 to 16 have been exposed to pornography. And 70% of the men between the ages of 18 to 34 visit pornography websites at least once a month. In fact, the largest consumers of pornography are 12 to 17-yearold boys. Correspondingly, similar studies have found that 1 in 6 women in the US struggle with pornography addiction.

What is wrong with watching pornography anyway?

First, engaging in pornography is sin. The Bible makes it clear that looking at a person with "lustful intent" is a sin (Mat. 5:28). Furthermore, the Apostle Paul asserted in 1 Cor 6 that the body of a true believer, bought and paid for by the blood of Jesus Christ our Saviour, is a temple of the Holy Spirit. As such, the body is meant for glorifying God, not self-pleasuring. According to this principle, masturbation, which is commonly associated with pornography, is also a sin. More than these, pornography is also a form of idolatry, where the human body is coveted and lusted after as an object of pleasure (Gal. 5:19-21). All human beings are created in the image of God (Gen. 1:27) and are fearfully and wonderfully

made by God (Psa. 139:14). As such, every human being has inherent value and dignity. But pornography debases the value of human beings and reduces them to mere objects of sexual pleasure.

Second, engaging in pornography, especially internet pornography, can cause addiction. The novelty of internet pornography, with new images, videos and stories being constantly uploaded, makes it highly addictive. In fact, a research by University of Cambridge in 2014 has shown that a person can be addicted to pornography just as to drugs. The word "addiction" comes from the Latin word "addicere," which means enslaved. Essentially, a person addicted to pornography is enslaved by it.

Third, research has also shown that consumption of pornography can lead to other sexual sins. According to McDowell Ministries (2021), research has found that pornography "is highly linked with sexual violence...and that clearly and consistently, pornography is linked to increased risks for committing sexual offences and accepting rape myths." Based on my experiences as a counsellor, heavy pornography usage can lead to other sexual sins such as paedophilia, molest and voyeurism. This is a natural consequence of addiction because the human brain develops tolerance to the particular substance or behaviour. And this leads to escalation, i.e. needing more of the substance or behaviour to achieve the same "high" as before. This leads a person who is addicted to pornography to search out more hardcore pornography and eventually act out what the person sees or reads.


