




# Where's your Confidence?


**If anyone else thinks he has  
reason for confidence in the  
flesh, **I have more:**—  
(Philippians 3:4b)**

**circumcised** on the eighth day,  
of the people of **Israel**,  
of the tribe of **Benjamin**,  
a Hebrew of **Hebrews**;  
as to the law, a **Pharisee**;  
(Philippians 3:5)



as to **zeal**, a persecutor of the church;  
as to righteousness under the law, **blameless**.  
(Philippians 3:6)





**But **whatever gain** I had, I  
**counted as loss** for the sake  
of **Christ**.  
(Philippians 3:7)**
