

EARTHLY TRIALS, GODLY PERSPECTIVES

When I took a film art class many years ago, one of my favourite movies was Rashomon. This 1950 Japanese classic pioneered a unique storytelling method, in which different eyewitnesses recount varying perspectives of the same event.

Rashomon showed how the same event could be viewed through different points of view. It came to mind recently, as I reflected on my journey with Melanie, my spouse, through her cancer. She completed several months of chemotherapy for ovarian cancer in November 2022. The cancer returned in August last year, and she has had to resume the treatments. God has used this long trial to change our perspectives. I list four examples here.

Perspective on provision — We live in a culture where it is common to complain, and praise is rarely given out. In our own flesh, we would probably bemoan why she has been so "unlucky" to be diagnosed with metastatic cancer in her early 40s. But, God has shown us how there is actually much to give thanks for, especially in how He has provided abundantly for our day-to-day needs. These blessings far outweigh the sufferings. Most importantly, we rest in the fact that God has given His Son, and promised us a glorious and painless future in eternity.

Perspective on priority — If life on earth is just a prelude to a glorious eternity, it raises the question of what we are spending time on. Are we building up treasures on this earth, or in heaven? Material possessions, earthly fame, as well as secular ambitions have dimmed in importance. Instead, building up

disciples in Christ, and finding opportunities to glorify God, have taken pre-eminence.

Perspective on power — Through the various surgeries and chemo treatments, God has taught us how His strength is made perfect in our weakness. He has shown us how He will continue to equip us to labour for Him, even with chipped and weathered jars of clay. He has brought us to the end of ourselves, and reminded us that we have an infinitely greater power in Him.

Perspective on people — We have received tremendous support and encouragement from close Christian friends. However, others have done the opposite, pushing the false doctrine that all Christians will be healed of sickness and disease. We could choose to be angry at them. But, we have learnt to view these incidents as God's way of turning our eyes even more towards Him and His eternal promises, rather than relying primarily on man's words for reassurance. We are also reminded of our own imperfection, and the need to be sensitive to others going through their own trials.

From an earthly perspective, this is a journey that Melanie and I would never have asked for. Yet, we can see how the darkness of this valley has shown us the dazzling beauty of God's glory and love. He has taught us that we should see what lies before us not as challenge, but as opportunity - to grow in Him and share our testimony, while we are able.

APIIS ENROLMENT

Dear Gospeliters,

As you may know, GLCC has a ministry called Asia-Pacific Institute of International Studies (APIIS)to train Asian Christian leaders. Since its inception in 1995 it has trained over 4000 Christian pastors/leaders. During the Covid lockdown, APIIS started a 2-year online Master of Ministry (MMin) program. So far, 535 Asian leaders have graduated from this program.

APIIS has received over 1300 applications for its MMin (2024/25) program. About half of these applicants are pastors and the other half are church leaders/members who want to serve God more effectively.

APIIS is inviting Gospeliters who want to "master their ministry," and who are willing to:

- spend 15 hours/week of self-study (using MMin videos and study guides)
- take weekly online MCQ tests
- attend a weekly 2 hour Zoom discussion




