







He shall lay his hand on the head of the burnt offering, and it shall be accepted for him to make <u>atonement</u> for him.



Thus the priest shall make <u>atonement</u> for him for the sin which he has committed in any one of these things, and he shall be <u>forgiven</u>.














Leviticus 7:11-12

VITTOUS DADADADADA

"And this is the law of the sacrifice of peace offerings that one may offer to the LORD. 
And he shall bring to the priest as his compensation to the LORD a ram without blemish out of the flock, or its equivalent, for a guilt offering.


















Hebrews 7:24-25
